Now comes an effort to devise and enact into law a single "consensus system" of acreage bases and pro-
duction yields for all crops and all farms, not subject to change with the passage of each successive two or four-year farm bill as in the past.
After more than a year of study, Congressman
Charles Stenholm of Stamford has introd Charles Stenholm of Stamford has introduced H. R. 4565, the "Agricultural Efficiency and Equity Act of
1983." The bill, Stenholm says, would provide a "skel etal structure" around which a wide variety of future
can be built.
An early draft of the proposal was discussed briefly in an October Plains Cotton Growers Board meeting and continues under study by PCG. An analysis of the bill as introduced November 18 will be available for January.
