And to top it off this year, Christmas comes on a Sunday. Of all things! It must happen like this every seven years or so since there are just seven days in a week. But every time it comes on a Sunday, it somehow seems to alarm us no end.

School Facilities Discussed At Meetings

A discussion of the building needs on the Bogata Campus was one of the major items of discussion for the December 13th Board meeting. A group of patrons, mostly from the Bogata area, were present at the meeting to express their concern and feelings about the need for improved facilities on that campus. In recent months, a study of the facilities of the entire school district had been made by Scott Partnership, an architectural firm out of Longview. Plans for various options had been presented to the Board for their consideration. The most recent option and the one receiving the most discussion at the meeting calls for new facilities on the Bogata Campus by utilizing the existing elementary building. The general feeling of the Bogata patrons was that they favored this plan rather than the one of periodically adding classrooms and other buildings to the presnet facilities. The pros and cons of a possible bond issue to

fund such a building program was discussed at length by Board members and patrons. No action on the matter was taken by the Board apart from an expression that the Board would strive to be receptive to what it considers to be a general feeling of the district on the issue. Approval was given to requesting that DR. N.B. Nelson, Chairman of the Administrative Education Department at East Texas State University, attend the January 10th meeting of the Board to act in an advisory capacity on this matter. Dr. Nelson has an extensive background in working with school districts on building needs. This matter will continue to be a topic of discussion at forthcoming meetings of the Board until some decision is reached.

In major action taken by the Board, a tax rate of \$.65 per \$100 valuation was set for the 1983 tax year. A total taxable value of \$156,335,320.00 for the school

district was recently approved by the Red River County Appraisal District. An effort is now being made to get the tax statements printed and then mailed to tax payers before the end of the year if at all possible. The school tax rate is normally set in August with tax statements being mailed in October, but due to various problems and delays in the new appraisal system, this will be the second year that statements are being mailed late. It is hoped that this does not occur in future

years.

The 1983 school audit report was approved by the Board after being reviewed for them by Billy Ed Griffis with the McClanahan & Holmes Auditing Firm. Mr. Griffis stated that the audit report reveals that the school district is in basic compliance with various auditing requirements.


In other action, the 1983-84 school calendar was amended making Monday, January 2, 1984 a holiday

since the 1st falls on a Sunday. Also, the 1984-85 school calendar was approved by the Board. The details of the new calendar will be made known to patrons in the near future. Approval was given to making a short term loan from the Talco State Bank, the school depository, to cover expenditures until tax revenue begins to come in.

In another matter, the Board was informed that the administration was working on a revised Promotion-

Retention Policy for grades K-8 which will be presented to the Board at a future meeting for their consideration.

In final action the Textbook Committee for the 1983-84 school year was approved and the various financial reports were accepted. The next regular meeting of the Board will be on Tuesday, January 10, 1984 at 7:00 p.m. in the Rivercrest High School with the general public cordially invited to attend.

Farmers Must Pay Estimated Tax Soon

If you are one of the individuals who earned at least two-thirds of your 1983 gross income from farming, you have until Monday, January 16, 1984 to make a 1983 declaration of estimated tax and to pay any taxes due.

However, according to the IRS, farmers who plan to file their 1983 income tax return and to pay the total tax balance by March 1, 1984 are not required to make an estimated tax declaration.

Additional information is available in the free IRS Publication 225, "Farmer's Tax Guide," and Publication 505, "Withholding and Estimated Tax." These publications can be obtained



AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF HEAVY TRUCK TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BOGATA, TEXAS, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOGATA, TEXAS:

a.) Route fixed. It shall be unlawful for any truck, tractor and semi-tractor, or any commercial motor vehicle with a rated capacity of one and one-half (1-1/2) tons or more according to the manufacturer's classification, or the equivalent thereof, to use any route other than U.S. Highway 271, State Highway 17, or Farm to Market Road 909 within the corporate limits of the City of Bogata, Texas.

b.) Penalty for violation. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$200.00.

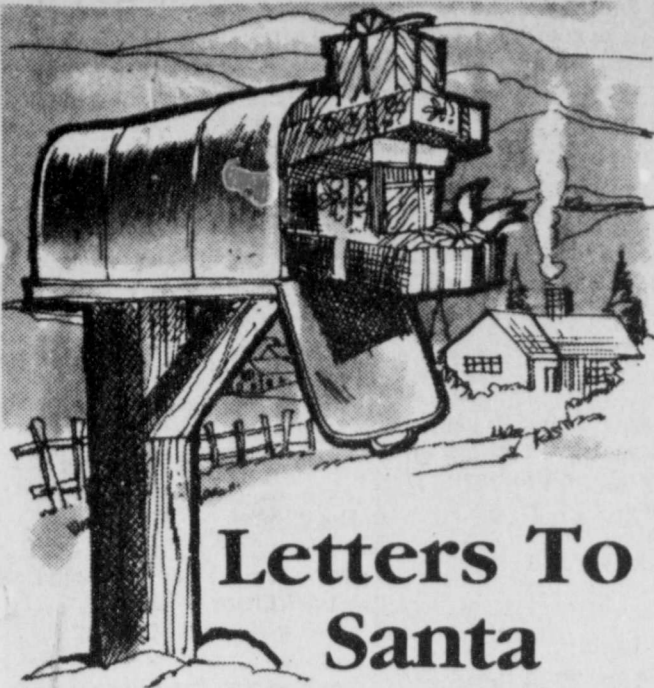

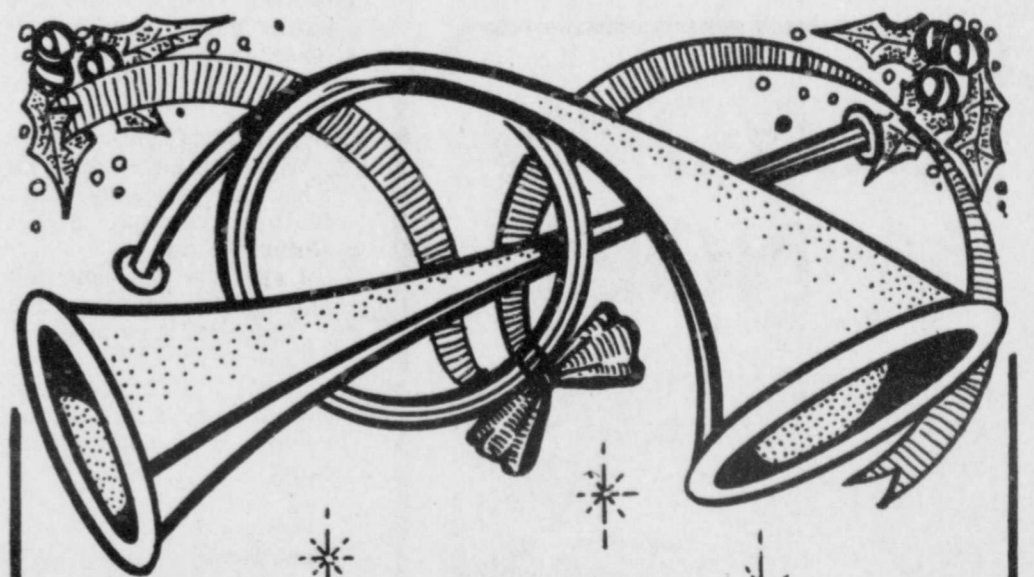

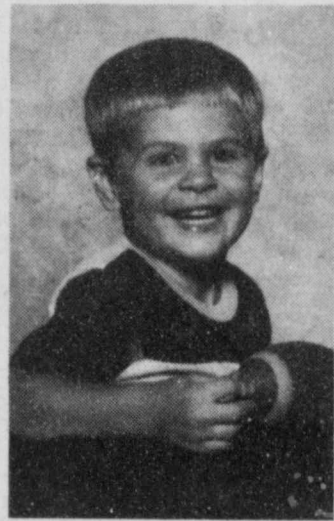
