

The beans began to run so the two women decided to go get the poles. Rose knew where there was an ash thicket, a couple of miels away, on Brushy Creek. There should be plenty of poles there.

One Saturday after dinner, while Dad and Swain had gone to town, Rose and Mother got Marion and I to hitch the mules to the wagon, then loaded all the kids and two axes and headed for the creek. We found plenty of good straight slender poles.

Everyone was so busy cutting and loading poles that no one saw a black cloud building up in the west. When it began to thunder, we realized that a

rain storm was approaching. We immediately loaded up and started home. Before we had gone very far, big drops of rain began to

splat down on us and we could see the storm coming up fast. Marion, Rose's oldest son, put the mules into a fast trot. We could see the rain streaking down across the prairie behind us as the lightning flashed and the thunder boomed. That just increased our speed.

We got home when the storm hit. We unhooked the team and turned them into the lot with the harness on, and ran to the house. By the time we got inside, the hail was coming down on the sheet iron roof with a deafening roar. When it was over, the ground was covered with balls of

The runnign beans were beat into the ground, but we had plenty of poles for next year.
