After I grew up it went away to college with me. The sound of my favorite station was a comfort at night.



## Eugene L. Norwood Eugene L. Norwood Dies February 28

Eugene L. Norwood, 61, of Cunningham, vice-president of the Paris Junio College Board of Regents, died Thursday, February 28 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Paris.

Mr. Norwood had served on the Board of Regents for over 22 years. In 1969, he was appointed to fill an unexpired term and was elected to the board in 1972. He became vicepresident in 1986.

Funeral services were held at 3 p.m. Saturday, March 2, in Life Tabernacle Church in Cunningham with the Rev. Don Whitt, the Rev. Lyndal Whitt and the Rev. Robert Myers officiating. Burial was in Restland Cemetery at Cunningham by Grant Funeral Home of Depot.

Mr. Norwood was born January 17, 1930 on the Norwood homeplace in Lamar County, a son of Almer Lewis and Alma Baker Norwood. He was a 1947 graduate of Cunningham High School and married Frances Geneva Watson on June 26, 1948. He served on the Cunningham School Board from 1956 until 1970 when the district consolidated with Prairiland. He was a past president of the Prairiland School Board.

He was a farmer, owner and operator of Eugene Norwood Housemoving Company, and was a member and board member of Life Tabernacle Church of Cunningham, and a board member of the Farmer's Home Administration.

Sam Crawford, 65, of Blossom died Monday, March 4 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Paris.



Dissolve yeast in warm water in large mixing bowl; let stand 5 minutes. Stir in our cream and next 5 ingredients. Add 1 1/2 cups flour, and beat at medium speed on electric mixer until smooth. Stir in remaining flour; cover and refrigerate 8

hours. Punch dough down; turn out onto lightly floured surface, and knead 2 times. Roll dough into 18x15" rectangle. Spread with 1/4 cup butter. Combine 1/2 cup sugar and cinnamon; sprinkle over rec-tangle. Carefully roll up dough jellyroll fashion, starting at long side; pinch seam to seal (do not seal ends). Cut roll into 1" slices; place slices, cut side down, in two greased 9" square pans.

Cover and let rise in a warm place, free from drafts, about 1 hour (rolls will not double in bulk). Bake at 375 for 18 to 20 minutes or until golden. Combine powdered sugar, milk and 1/2 teaspoon vanilla, stirring well. Drizzle over warm rolls. Yield: 1 1/2 dozen.







The election itself is not difficult to make, and it is not generally a taxable event. If the requirements are met, the S status may be used permanently or temporarily, as conditions dictate. The main benefit of the election is that the corporation does not generally pay federal income tax on its net income Rather, the income flows through to its shareholders who report their share of

réturns. In general, a corporation will qualify to elect S corporation status if the corporation is a domestic corporation, has only one class of stock, and has no more than 35 shareholders. Additionally, the shareholders can only be individuals, estates and certain trusts. Individual shareholders must be citizens or residents of the U.S.
