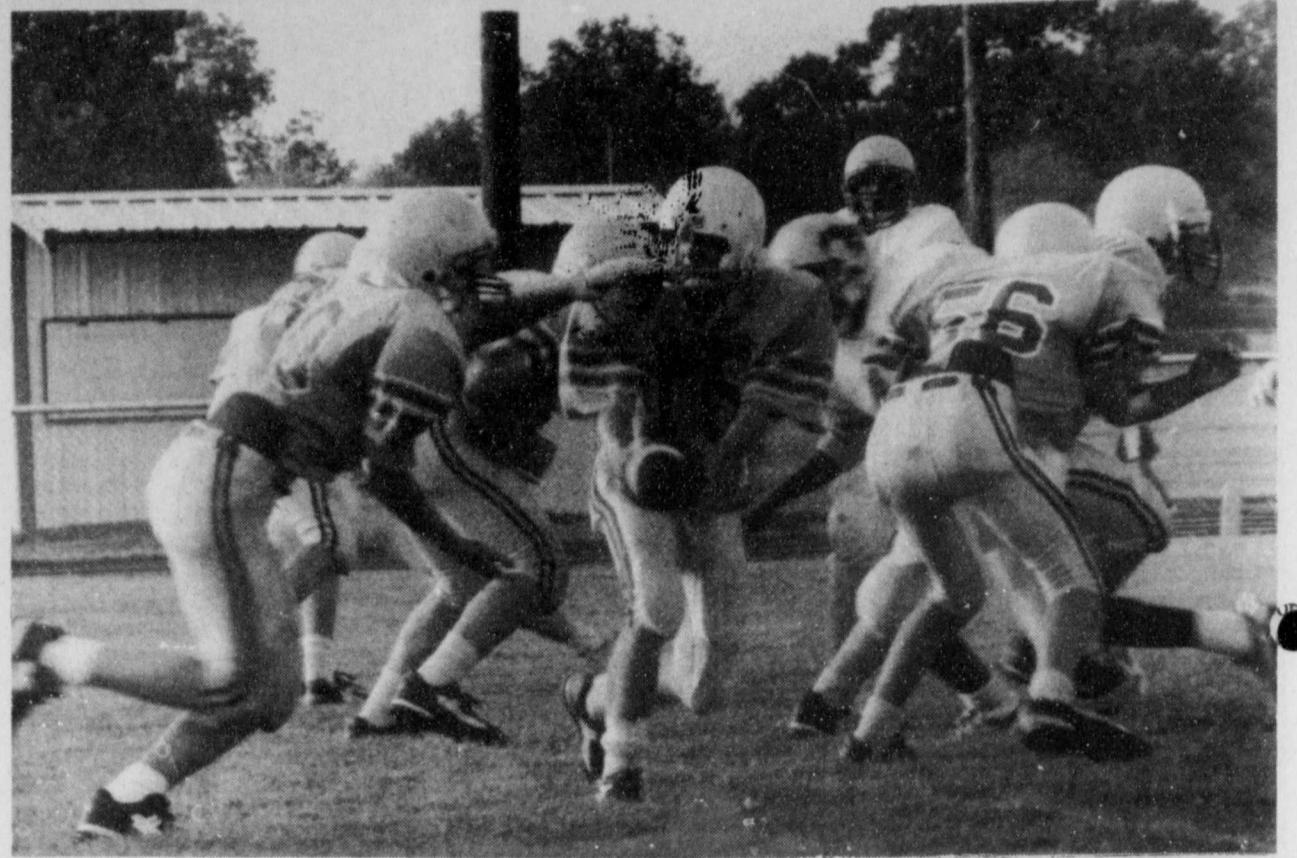


# Rebel Sports Report

Rebecca is the daughter of Anne Randolph and the granddaughter of Frances Griffin of Bogata.

Assistant Curator of Education at the the Caldwell Zoo in Tyler is the title that Rebecca wears on a daily basis but on weekends and during her free hours she is in the business of buying and selling dolls. A graduate of Rivercrest High School and the University of Texas at Tyler, Rebecca has a degree in political science and a secondary teaching certificate. She lectures to groups of all ages about the wildlife in the zoo. Their habits, diet, lifestyle preference and personalities are her speciality. She is as at home with a python as most are with the family pet.

Several years ago Rebecca started putting to good use her interest in history and became aware that her collection of dolls had profit potential. 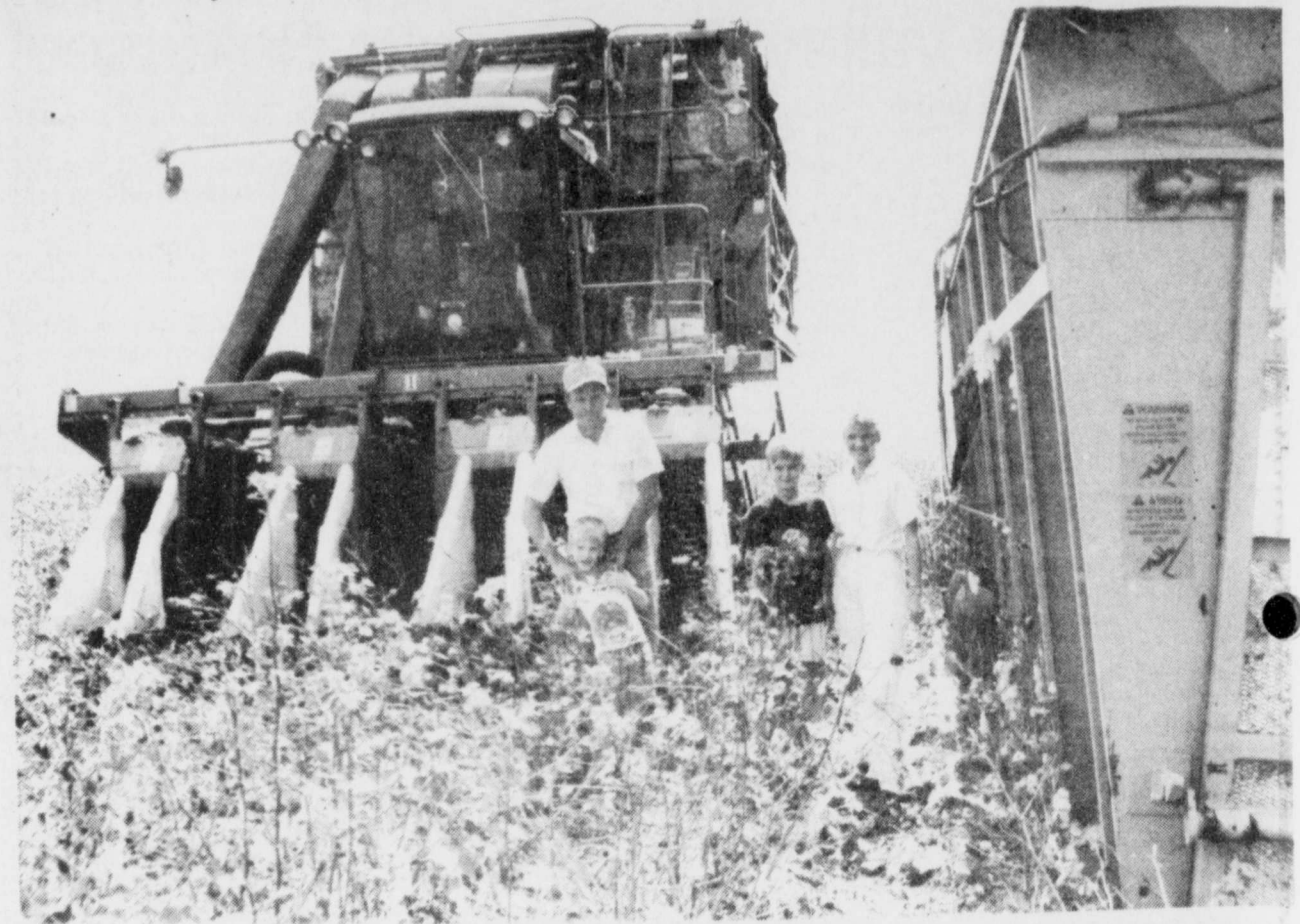

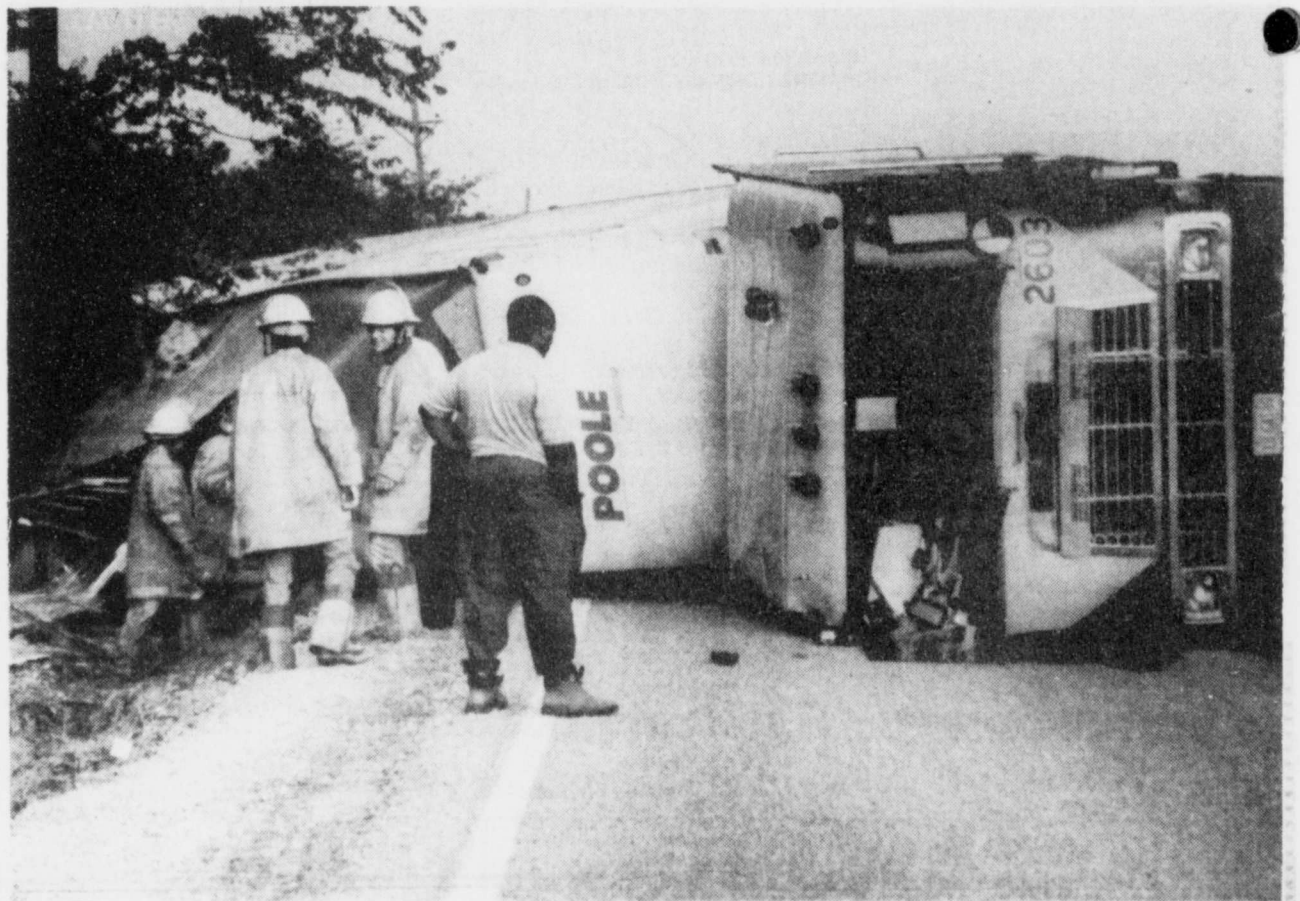
**Notice of Vote on Tax Rate**

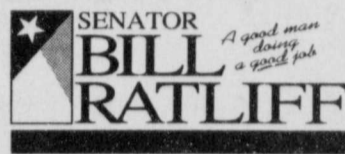

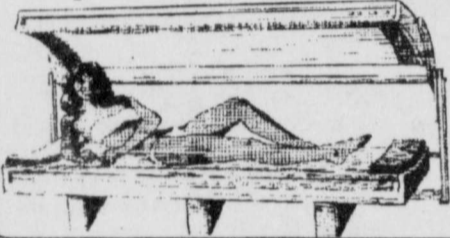

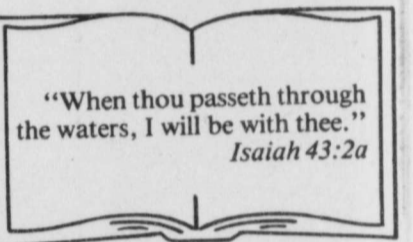
