In Psalm 107:2 we find these words: "Let the redeemed of the Lord say so."

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is our Savior — our Redeemer. It is by His atoning grace and through our faith in Him that we are "the redeemed of the Lord" mentioned in the Psalm.

A genuine Christian should be glad for every opportunity to share Christ with those about Him. Thus, the psalmist says that if we are saved

(redeemed) we ought to let it be known: "Let the redeemed of the Lord say so".

Every care must be taken, however, to be genuine in "saying so". Sometimes, what we ARE speaks so loudly people cannot hear what we SAY. We may SAY we are a Christian, but if we do not ACT (or live) like it, all our "saying so" is in vain and becomes mockery and even hypocrisy.

If you ARE redeemed, the best way to SAY SO may not

be to give verbal testimony of your salvation, but to PROVE your salvation by your very life.

Take this acrostic as a guide: W-A-T-C-H your W-ords, your A-actions, your T-thoughts, your C-companions, — yea, your very H-heart. In these things you can DO and BE what a Christian should, and through these things you (the redeemed of the Lord) can "say so" without "saying so".
