The best way to avoid getting em-
physema, a chronic obstructive lung physema, a chronic obstructive lung
disease, is not to smoke. In few ailments is the cause and effect so clear. When cigarette smoke, contain-
ing more than 4,000 toxic chemicals, ing more than 4,000 toxic chemicals, the walls of the small airways. Microscopic examination shows these
chemicals eventually destroy lung tissue.
If smokers who do not have emphysema stop smoking before developing lung cancer, then their risk
of contracting cancer after $2-5$ years is much the same as that of non-
smokers. smokers.

smoking cessation does lead to certain improvements, but permanent tissue damage remains.
