Most of the corporate farms who have tried to produce common marketable goods have had to give up and go back to products for which they could control the marketing as well as the production. With the exception of a few cases our largest production of
every agricultural product has come from what has been known as the family farm. A recent anylist survey showed that there is no way that large corporate farms can produce as cheap as the smaller farmer with constant attention to smaller acreage. There is also so much crop diversification that if we were run by
corporations on the farm more than half the products raised corporations on the farm more than half the products raised
would be eliminated Russian agriculture has proven the larger the operation in farming the less efficiency of production. There may come a day when the largest percent of the land is farmed by farming corporations but to make it interesting to investors in these corporations, the profit in farming will have to do a lot
