MUSTANGS BEAT SHAMROCK 22-0

Mustangs Beat Shamrock; After an ugly and sluggish three quarters of football, the Wheeler Mustangs exploded for 22 points and rolled over the Fighting Irish in Shamrock last Friday night. The win clinched a playoff berth for the Mustangs and a win over Gruver next Friday will give the Mustangs a likely second seed.

The ugliness started early for the Mustangs after receiving the opening kickoff. QB Holden Guest ran for four yards. On second down he handed off to RB Rudy Almanza. Almanza picked up three yards but, fighting for extra yards, the ball was stripped away and recovered by Shamrock at the Irish 42.

The Irish could not capitalize and punted away after three plays. Wheeler took over at their 35, but immediately lost eight yards on first down when Guest and Almanza botched a handoff and Guest lost eight yards after the recover. They got 13 yards on second down when Guest connected with WR Ivan Lopez to put the Mustangs in a manageable third and five. They seemed to

pick up a first down on the next play, but a chop block penalty cost them 13 yards and were forced to punt two plays later.

Shamrock ran six plays to the Mustang 45 and punted, giving the Mustangs possession at the 20. On second and 24 RB Eduardo Porras raced for 24 yards to the 40 to give Wheeler a fresh set of downs. But the drive stalled out three plays later and P Servando Rascon's 37 yard punt gave the Irish possession at the

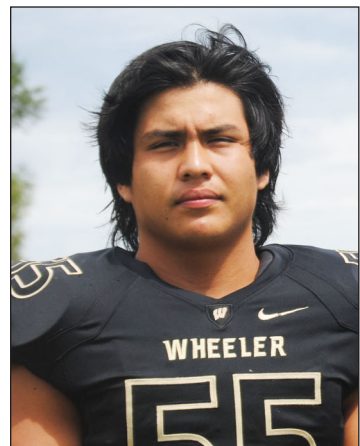

Shamrock 29. From there the Irish went on a grinding drive, running the ball 13 consecutive plays down to the Mustang 23. But on second and 11 Shamrock QB Levi Fullbright fumbled and Mustang LB Almanza pounced on the loose ball.

Guest connected with Lopez on the next play for 13 yards to the 36. Two plays later Guest appeared to throw a 63 yard TD pass to WR Traylen Drake (Continued Page 5)

Guest had three touchdown passes and a 51-yard rushing score. Receiver **Ivan Lopez** hauled in seven catches for 107 yards and a TD.

A MIGHTY FINE HAIRCUT

As I've said before, Dad was in the Navy during WWII. I've also mentioned that he was a small man, five foot four and a hundred and thirty five pounds. When I was young, he told me several things about boot camp that I thought was

really funny. He said that when he got to the induction center, one of the first things they did, was to get rid of their civilian clothes and were given navy clothes. The folks issuing them, would just look at you and guess what size you needed. As you might expect, his were all too big. This inspired a lot of desperate swapping of clothes. He eventually got some that fit him better. Next on the agenda, was haircuts. A few of the "barbers" had a little sense of humor though. He said when the young man just ahead of him sat down in the chair the barber asked him how he would like for him to cut

it. The young man said, "Just a little off the top and tapered in the back." The barber then left it about a quarter inch long all over, classical G I style. Next on the agenda were "shots." Dad said they just walked in a line when people on each side would give you a shot as you passed by. and it wasn't an easy one. Dad was an excellent swimmer, so it wasn't hard for him, but he felt sorry for some of the guys who couldn't swim when they got there, and had to stay until they did learn. It just wouldn't seem right, for a Sailor to not be a swimmer.

PRACTICE FIREARM SAFETY

Hunters and other sportsmen should make firearm safety a top priority. Accidents with firearms don't just happen. They are caused by haste, carelessness or disregard for safety rules.

With hunting season at hand, hunters should review and practice firearm safety rules. Below are guidelines for firearm safety:

>Treat every gun with the respect accorded to a loaded gun.

>Watch that muzzle. Be able to control the direction of the muzzle even if you should stumble.

>Be sure the barrel and action are clear of obstructions and that ammunition is of the

proper size for the gun you carry.

>Be sure of your target and know what lies beyond your target before you pull the trigger. Rifle trajectories can travel 1 mile or further. Know the identifying features of the game you hunt.

>Unload guns when they are not in use. Take down or have actions open. Guns should be carried in cases to the shoot-

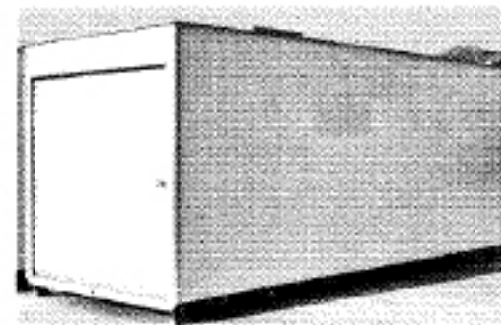

but another chop block penalty disregarded the score. Guest ran for three yards on second and 24 and facing third and 21 he attempted a pass over the middle but Irish FS Eckx Williams stepped in front at the 46 and returned the interception to the Mustang 18.

The Irish failed to take advantage of the excellent field position and turned the ball over on downs four plays later at the 15. The Mustangs took over with 55 seconds left and a Guest run and three passes (one to Drake for ten yards, two to Lopez for 25 yards) moved the ball to the Irish 42 with four seconds left. Guest

attempted to deep pass, but Shamrock CB Alex Dougherty knocked it down and the teams went into halftime tied at 0-0.

Penalties killed Shamrock's first drive of the second half and punted to the Mustang 27. Wheeler gave the ball back on the following play when Guest was striped after a four yard gain and the Irish once again had great field position at the 31. Once again a penalty doomed the Irish to a third and 18. RB Eckx Williams lost control on the third down carry and Mustang LB Guest jumped on the fumble and Wheeler took over at their 38.

Wheeler notched a big play three plays later when facing a third and nine, Guest hit Lopez for a 26 yard gain to the Irish

34. But another chop block penalty killed the drive and Rascon punted to the Irish 16. A penalty and a stout Mustang defense forced Shamrock into a fourth and 15 from the 11. Irish P Emperor Williams dropped back to punt but the long snap sailed over his head and out of the end zone to end the scoreless streak and gave Wheeler a safety and a 2-0 lead late in the third quarter.

The Mustangs received the ensuing kickoff and set up at their 19. Guest ran for 16 yards on the first play from scrimmage but four plays later faced a fourth and seven from the 38. Wheeler spread the field and appeared to give Guest a punt pass option. Guest properly read the defense and zipped

a pass to Porras for 23 yards and a first down at the Irish 39. One the next play Guest threw a hitch pass to Drake on the left sideline. Drake picked up a block, shook a tackle and raced down the field. Around the 23 he skillfully leapt over an attempted to tackle and then stepped out of another diving tackle attempt at the 8 and ran into the end zone. K Rascon added the PAT and the Mustangs lead 9-0 with 10:41 left in the game.

The Wheeler defense stymied the Irish on the ensuing possession and forced an apparent punt from the Shamrock 27. But Shamrock tired a fake punt that failed after alert Mustang DB Gustavo Andrade broke up the pass attempt and

the Mustangs took over. After an incompleton on first down. Guest took the shotgun snap and fired a quick pass over the middle to TE Levi Ware. Ware powered through two attempted tackles and rumbled into the end zone. The two point attempt failed and Wheeler led 15-0 with 8:26 to play.

The Irish could not move the ball and had to punt from their four. A 23 yard punt gave the Mustangs outstanding field position from the Shamrock 27. Wheeler picked up a first down three plays later on a

Guest to Drake 11 yard pass to the 14. Three plays later, facing a third and 13, Guest threw to Lopez in the near corner of the end zone. Lopez just got his hands under the pass and he Mustangs finished off the scoring at 22-0 after Rascon's Pat with 3:19 to play.

It was refreshing to see the potent Mustang offense finally break out after only scoring a single TD over the previous seven quarters. And while the Irish held the Mustangs to only 72 rushing yards on 26 carries, QB Guest complete 11 passes to four receivers for 211 yards and three TD's. The Mustang defense more than did its job, allowing only 111 yards of total offense and seven first downs and holding the Irish out of the end zone all evening. The regular season ends this Friday night at Nicholson Field as the Mustangs (5-4, 3-1) host the Gruver Greyhounds (4-5, 3-1) at 7pm. The game will effectively determine the second seed in District 1-2A Division II. Hope to see a large turnout to send off the seniors playing their final home game of their high school careers.

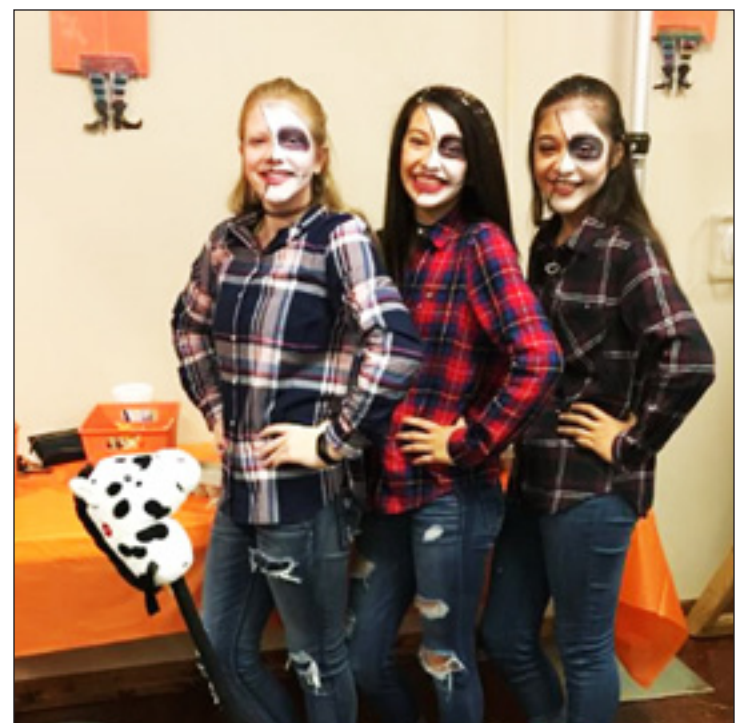
