The commissioners' Court of Wheeler County, Texas, met in regular session on Monday, January 9, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Courtroom of the Wheeler County Courthouse at 401 Main Street, Wheeler, Texas to consider prior bills and discuss matters of mutual concern.

At 10:00 a.m. court was reconvened to address the 20 items on the agenda.

The minutes of the previous meetings were approved as presented.

The monthly revenue reports were accepted as presented: Justice of the Peace, Pct. 1, \$9,552.90; Justice of the Peace, Pct. 2, \$44,394.20; County Tax Collector \$650,445.61; County

Clerk, 22,262.38; and District Clerk, \$8,082.58. The County Treasurer's Disbursement for the period of December 22, 2016 through January 9, 2017 was \$106,663.34.

There were no budget amendments.
