On May 6, 2017, voters will go to the polls to elect members to area school boards, city councils and Parkview Hospital Board. Filing for names to be placed on the ballot for these positions opened Wednesday, January 18.

**Parkview Hospital**  
Three places on the

Parkview Hospital Board are to be filled with the upcoming election. Positions are Precinct 1, Precinct 2 and At Large. These places are presently held by Janie VanZandt, Roy Laughlin and Pam Hibler, respectively.

Filing for the hospital board opened January 18, 2017 and

the last date for filing is February 17, 2017.

Individuals in the North Wheeler County Hospital District may file for the board at Parkview Hospital, 901 S. Sweetwater Street, Wheeler, Texas.

### City of Wheeler

Three places on the Wheeler City Council are to be filled in the May 6 election. Place one on the Council is presently held by Carol Porton. Britt McCarter's term expires as representative for Place 3. Place 5 is also expiring; Kendall Hefley presently holds that position.

The deadline for filing for a placing on the ballot is February 17, 2017.

Applications to file may be obtained at the City office located at 505 Alan L. Bean Blvd. between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

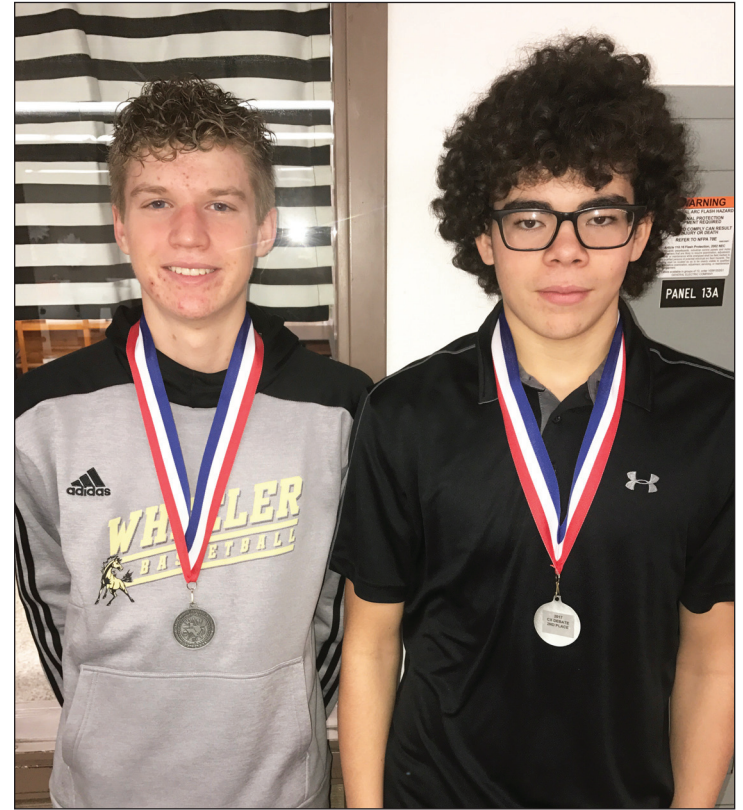
### Wheeler I.S.D.

Continuing to advance in his profession, in 2001 Mike took a job as an oil & gas consultant for Sierra Engineering and he and Jan moved to Hinton, OK

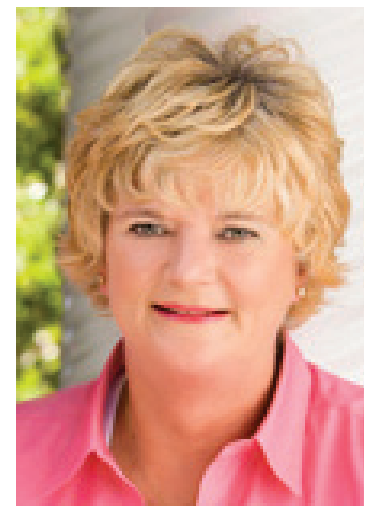
In November of 2003, Mike purchased Louvier Fluid Hot Oil Service located in Pampa, TX and Mike and Jan moved to Wheeler TX.

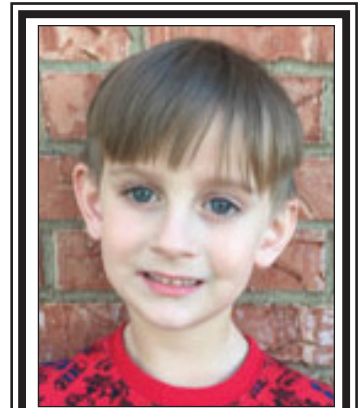

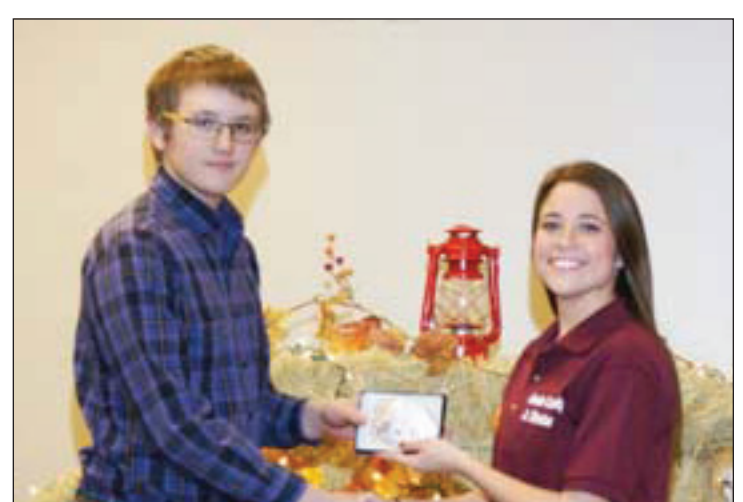
