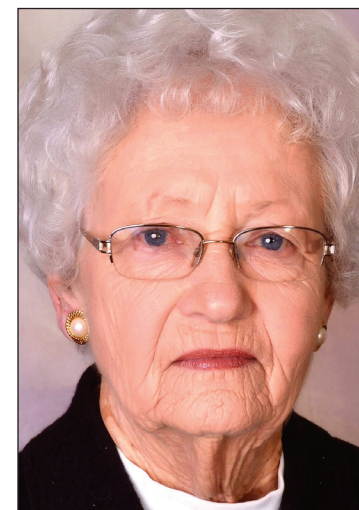
## Seven Individuals Advance To Area

## Changes Are Announced For County 2017 Farmers' Market

The Wheeler Farmers' Market is changing starting with the 2017 growing season. We have been a Wheeler County Market exclusively for Wheeler County with only locally grown produce and have been fairly small with no more than 10 vendors per market. We are now going to open our market up to the adjoining counties of Hemphill, Gray, and Collingsworth and the new name of the market will be Eastern Panhandle Farmers' Market. Growers from these counties have shown interest in our market but were restricted from joining. We are one of the last farmers' markets left in the Texas Panhandle and we offer a good selection of fruits and vegetables. We are not allowed to bring in produce from out-of-state or out of the designated counties.

Each vendor will be responsible for his/her sales, table, chairs, bags, tent (if preferred), money box, etc. The market is open to all ages and will be held in Wheeler on Saturdays 9 to noon on the west side of the courthouse and on Wednesdays 3 to 6

pm on the east side of the courthouse (along hwy 83). If you are interested go ahead and make plans by ordering your seeds and as the winter weather winds down be getting your garden spots ready for next spring/summer. The market usually runs from July 4th until Oct. 4th. A notice will be printed later. 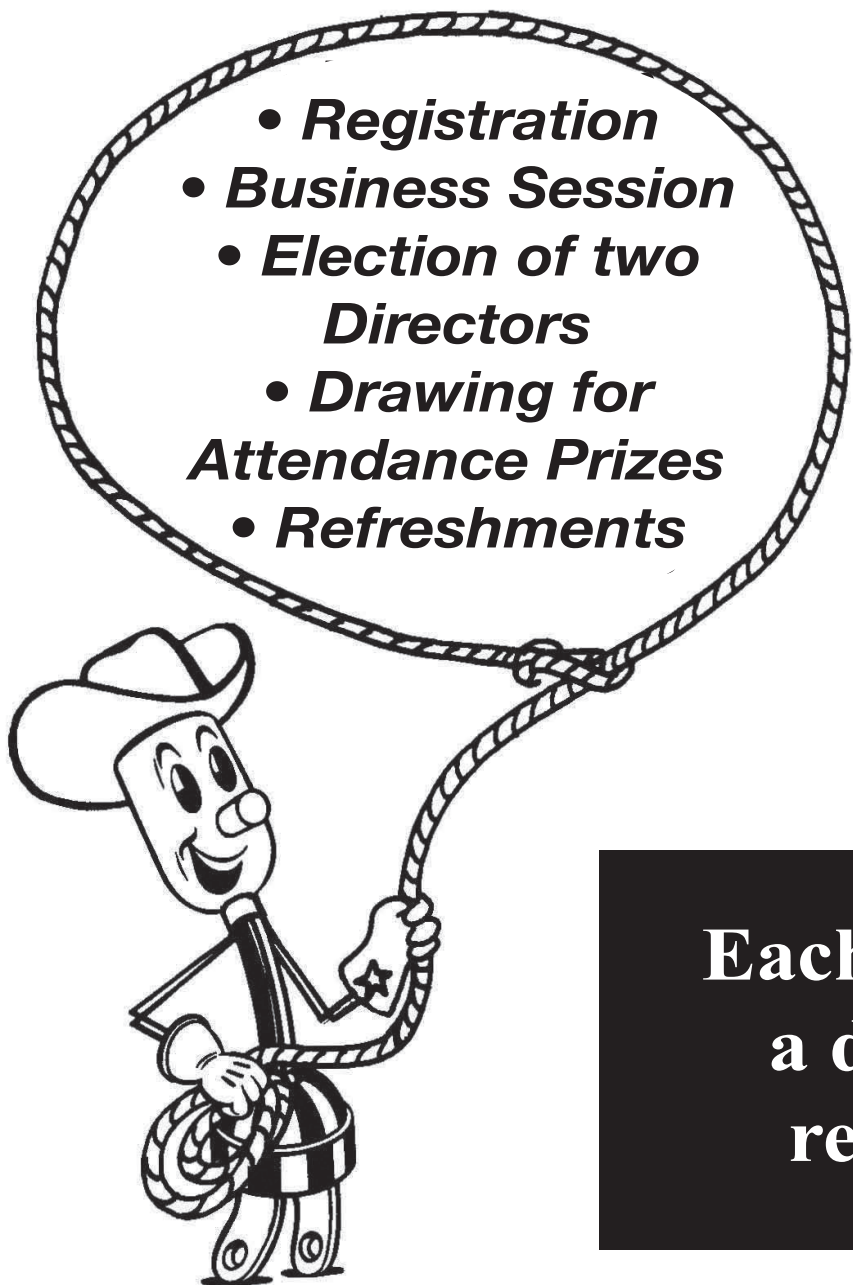

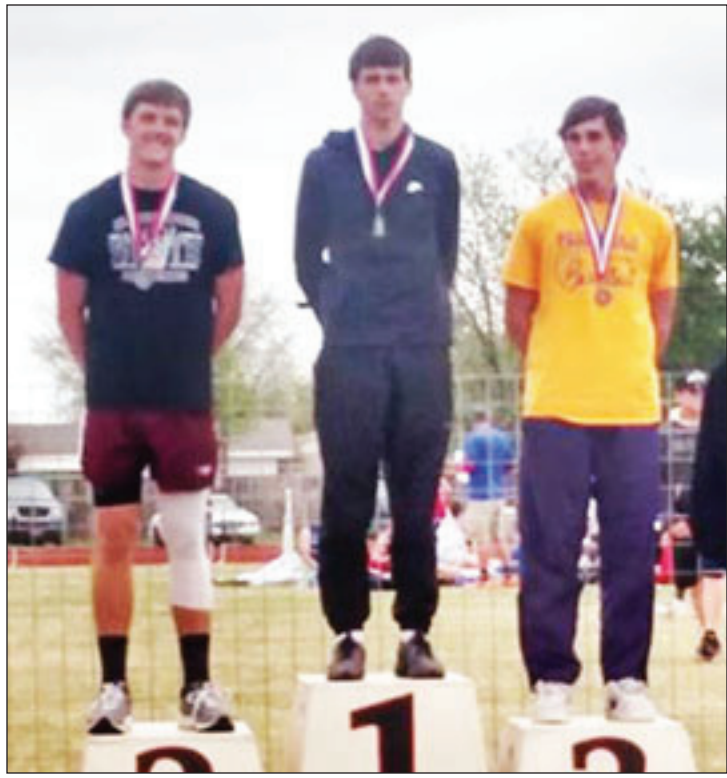

## Renewal Options For Conservation Program

USDA's Largest Conservation Program Helps Producers Improve Health, Productivity of Working Lands

WASHINGTON, March 31, 2017 – Acting Deputy Agriculture Secretary Michael Young has announced that a contract renewal sign-up is underway for the Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP), USDA's largest working lands conservation program with more than 80 million acres enrolled.

Participants with existing CSP contracts that will expire on Dec. 31 can renew their contract for an additional five years if they agree to adopt additional activities to achieve higher levels of conservation on their lands. Applications to renew expiring contracts are due by May 5.

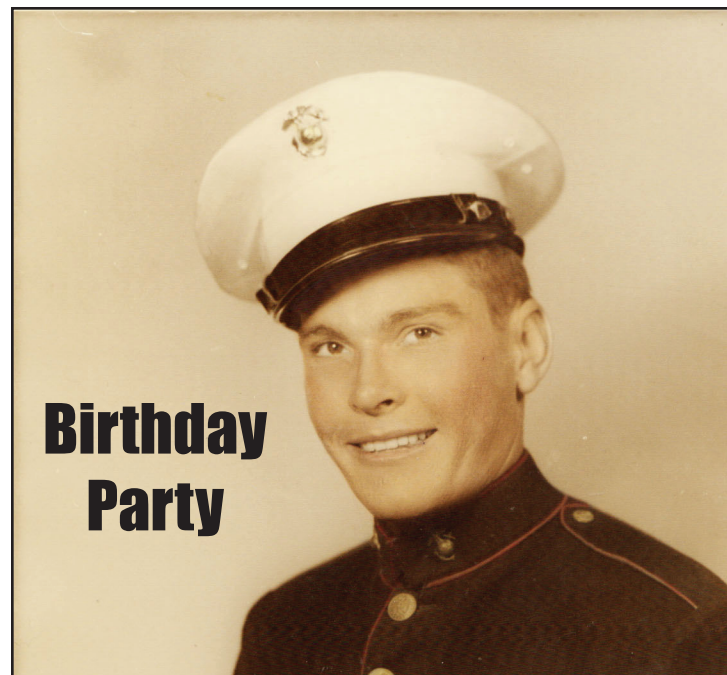

 buffer strips, pollinator and beneficial insect habitat, and soil health building activities – all while maintaining active agricultural production on their land. Benefits to producers can include:  
 Improved cattle gains per acre;  
 Increased crop yields;  
 Decreased inputs;  
 Wildlife population improvements; and  
 Better resilience to weather extremes.

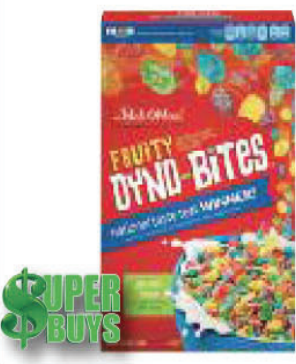
