### Annas Florene Seitz Annas Seitz Rites Are Held In Pampa

Annas Florene Seitz, 91, of Pampa, died May 26, 2017 in Pampa.

Services were at 10:00 A.M. Tuesday, May 30, 2017, at Carmichael-Whately Colonial Chapel, with Rev. Norman Rushing, pastor of Central Baptist Church, officiating. Burial followed in Mobeetie Cemetery under the direction of Carmichael-Whately Funeral Directors.

Mrs. Seitz was born November 21, 1925 in Wheeler County. She grew up in the Wheeler and Mobeetie areas. When she was 11, she was baptized on the Britt Ranch. Annas was a graduate of Mobeetie High School. She married Loy Seitz on December 24, 1943 while Loy was on leave during World War II. He preceded her in death in 1972. Annas was a homemaker and active in the Mobeetie community before moving to Pampa. She was a longtime and active member of Central Baptist Church for 44 years. She was a loving mother, grandmother, great grandmother and sister and will be greatly missed by family and friends.
