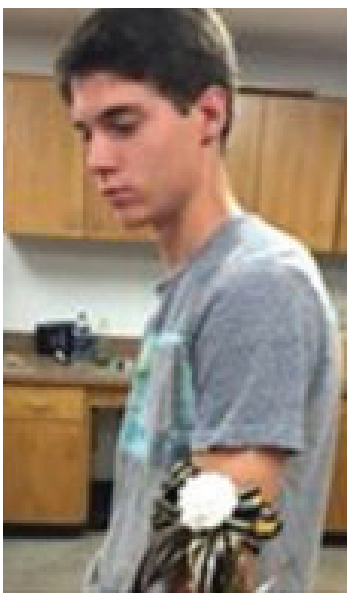

A NOTE FROM THE Wheeler Cemetery Association

I felt it was time to explain some things about the Wheeler Cemetery Association. We are a group of people that work together to take care of the cemetery and sell spaces when needed. The spaces sell for \$250.00 each and once a year we send dues which are \$5.00 per space.

At the time spaces are bought we give a copy of the rules for owning a space. If anyone would like to read those or have a copy, we would be glad to give them

to you.

As far as expenses go, we pay Excel for electricity on a monthly basis, pay for weed spraying, and mowing in the summer, and pay Robert Brickey for doing some work including trying to control the gopher population. The mowing and spraying are our major expense. The spraying cost is approx. \$6000.00 per spraying and the mowing is \$1500.00 every time it is mowed. The mowing is more pushmower and weedeater due to getting around headstones etc. The only income

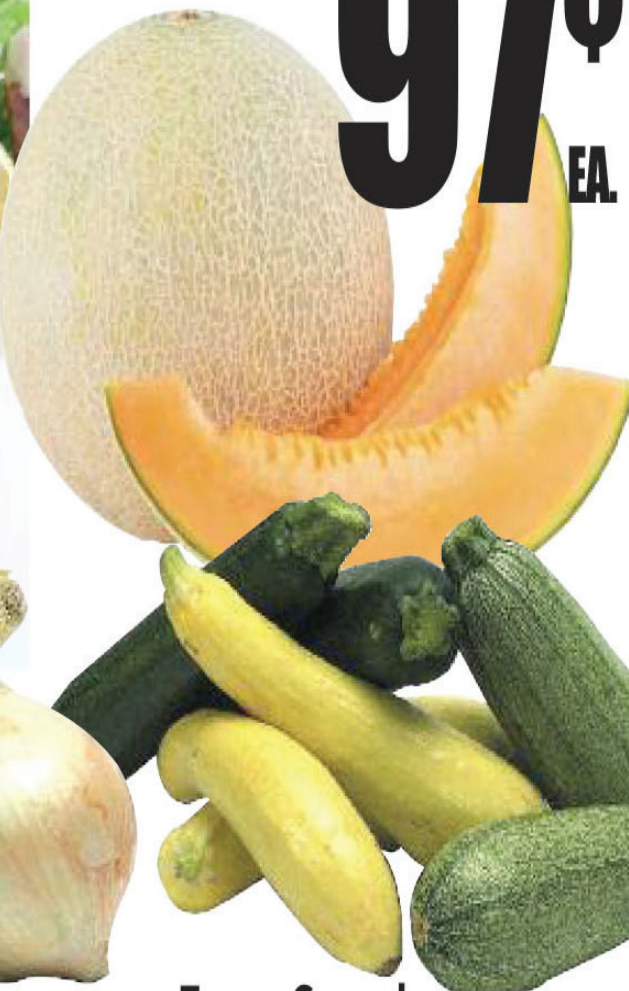
