## Motor Cycle Wreck Claims Driver's Life

The Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) was called to a one-vehicle crash Sunday on FM-1046 in Wheeler County, resulting in the death of one person.

At approximately 7:25 p.m., Robert Gonzales, 56, of Pampa, was driving a 2005 Harley Davidson west on FM-1046 approximately five miles northwest of Mobeetie. Gonzales failed to negotiate a curve in the roadway which caused him to lose control of the motorcycle and ultimately fall off.

Gonzales was pronounced dead on scene by Wheeler County Justice of the Peace, Mark Brown.

Gonzales was not wearing a helmet.

The road conditions were dry and no other vehicles were involved.

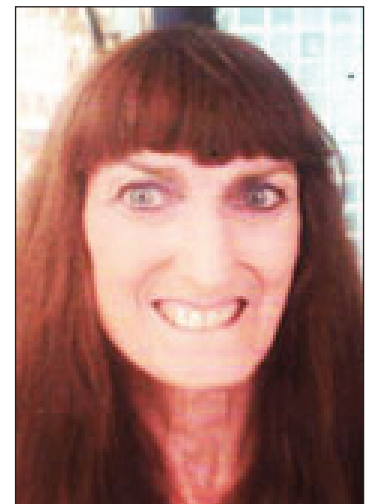

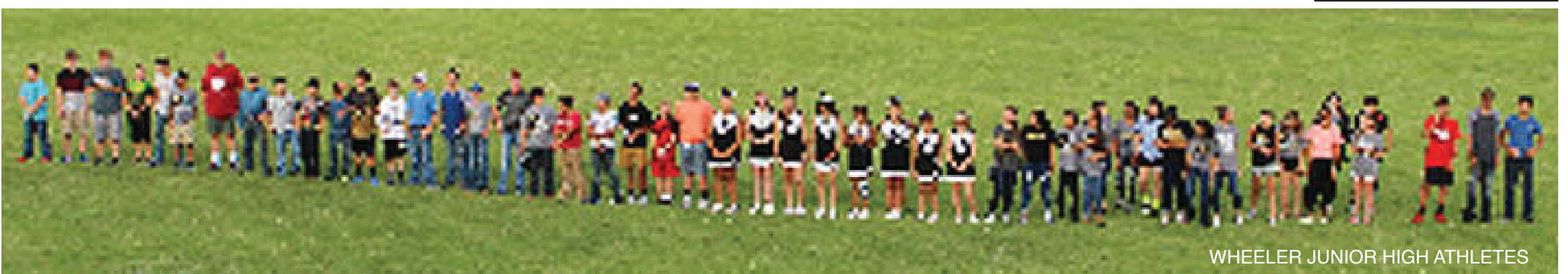

look for the future. Despite the loss of additional funding from the State, financial measures have been implemented to assure the stability of the District for years to come. This comes amid reports that Ft. Elliott had a limited number of years to remain open. Beginning last spring, the Ft. Elliott Board of Trustees took extraordinary steps to lay the groundwork to ensure that Ft. Elliott CISD would be financially sound for the future and to continue providing the best education for its students.

Among the steps taken, the Mobeetie Elementary campus was relocated to a central location in Briscoe. This has allowed the District to save the cost associated with having two separate campuses and to be able to consolidate services for students into one location. Thus far, it has been exciting to have all of our elementary students together with our Jr. High and High school. A positive factor associated with the relocation is that parents that have both elementary and secondary students are in one location, as well as, being able to take advantage of all of the district's outstanding facilities.

**Xcel Submits Rate Review For Bills**

Increased base rates to recover costs of strengthening grid, boosting power supplies (Aug. 21, 2017) – Today, Xcel Energy submitted a rate review to Texas regulators that



seeks an additional \$66.4 million of revenues to cover costs associated with strengthening the regional power grid and securing ample power sup-

plies at competitive costs well into the future. The additional revenue would increase Texas retail customer bills 7.1 percent overall.

The filing requests an adjustment to prices in 2018 that will incorporate \$758 million in electric infrastructure upgrades since early 2016 as Xcel Energy continues to build an energy future that delivers reliable and plentiful energy at the lowest cost possible. These improvements include new power lines, substations and power plant upgrades that have already been placed into service for the benefit of customers.

A second driver of the request includes a shift in costs related to delivering a larger share of low-cost energy from existing power plants to Xcel Energy's towns and cities as wholesale contracts with regional electric co-ops expire. In 2007, Xcel Energy's Texas stakeholders desired, and Xcel Energy agreed, to terminate wholesale power sales so that Xcel Energy's retail customers could use the lower-cost resources.

"Xcel Energy is committed to building an energy future that delivers value to our customers and our communities," said David Hudson, president.



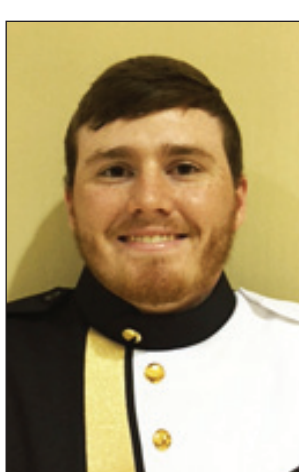
