


their dresses. Jaci Guest was the Homecoming Queen. Mrs. Moore did an awesome job.



ALONE? Since many people are alone when they suffer a heart attack without help, the person whose heart is beating improperly and who begins to feel faint, has only about 10 seconds left before losing consciousness.
