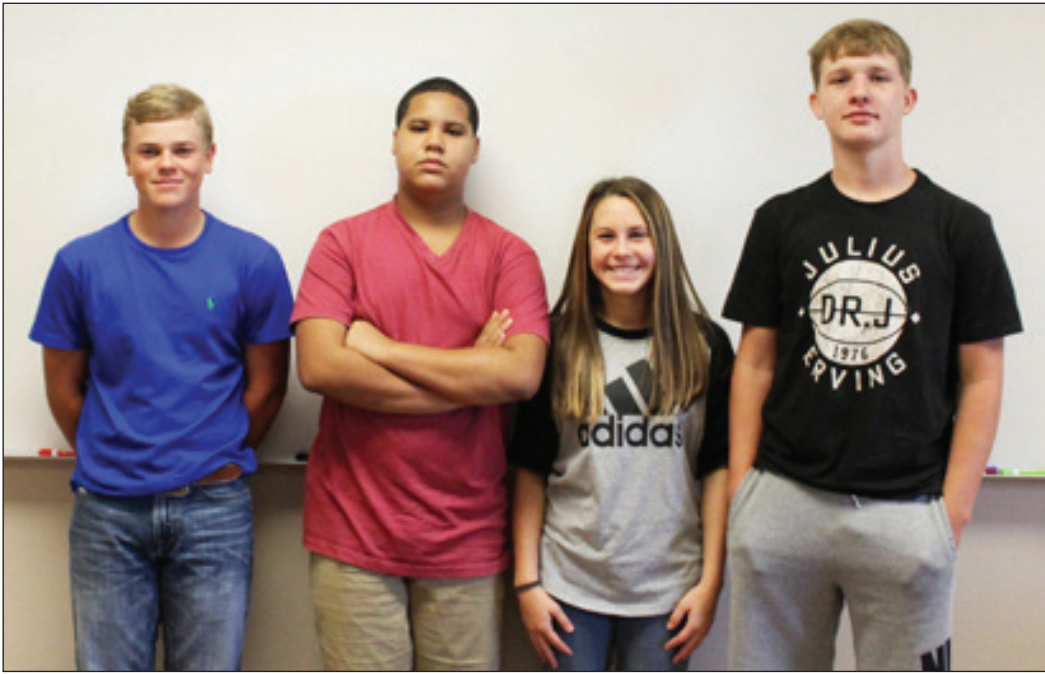

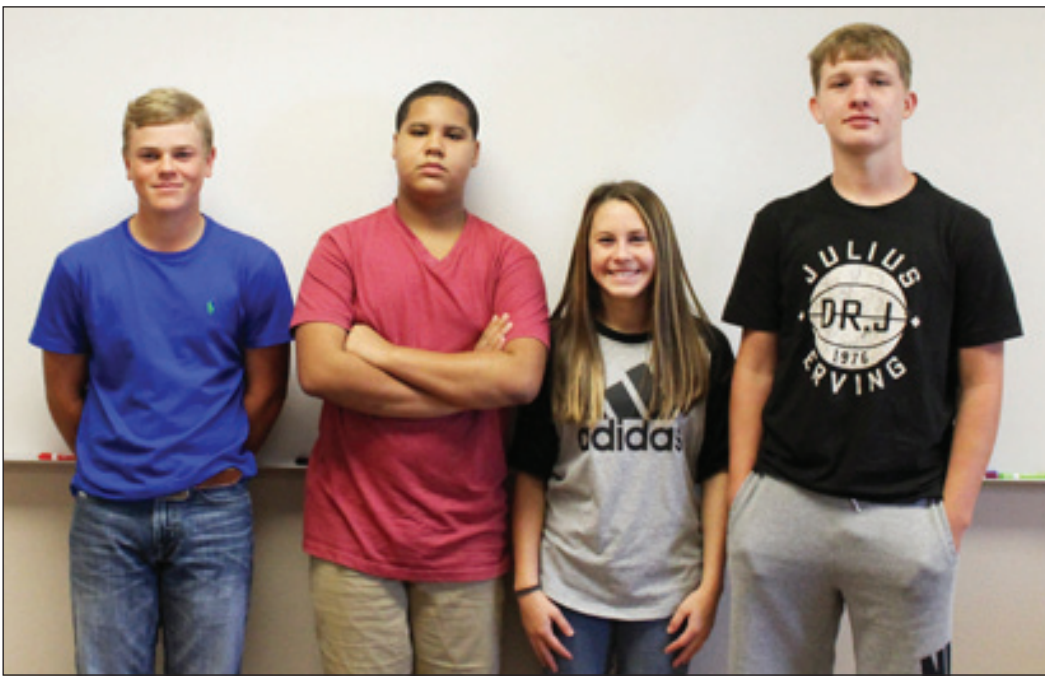

ALONE? Since many people
are alone when they suffer a
heart attack without help, the
person whose heart is beating
improperly and who begins
to feel faint, has only about
10 seconds left before losing
consciousness.

7. However, these vic-
tims can help themselves
by coughing repeatedly and
very vigorously. A deep breath
should be taken before each
cough, and the cough must be
deep and prolonged, as when
producing sputum from deep
inside the chest. A breath and
a cough must be repeated
about every two seconds with-
out let-up until help arrives,
or until the heart is felt to be
beating normally again.
