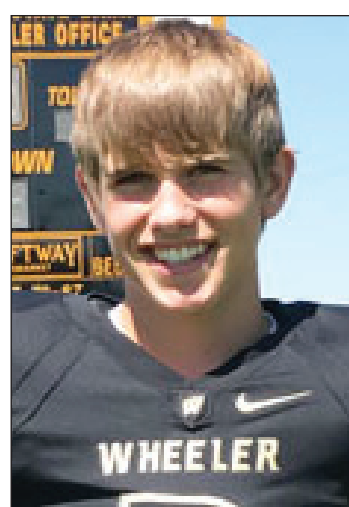
## Willeford Fund Established

The Wheeler Times stands by their headline "\$90,000 Budgeted For Shamrock Dispatch" in the September 28, 2017 edition of the paper. Since the headline was said to be in error, research recovered some additional information.

Item #12 on the September 25, 2017 Wheeler County Commissioners' agenda read "Consideration of Dispatch Service Contract with City of Shamrock, Texas. When #12 came up for action, Commissioner David Simpson immediately motioned to approve the contract. Sheriff Crites was asked if he was aware how the contract read; he was not. A copy of the contract was furnished for Crites to read; the court was informed that his department no longer used the Shamrock Dispatch—as the county's equipment was newer and better. After a pause in the meeting to change the tape in the recorder, Commissioner Simpson immediately made a motion to approve the contract and Commissioner John Walker seconded. The motion was passed with John Walker, David Simpson and Bob Hink voting in favor and Commissioner Steve Walker voted against.

\$90,000 was budgeted for the Shamrock Dispatch prior to the September 25, 2017 approval of the Dispatch Service Contract with the City of Shamrock. The annual contract had not been renewed since 2010, but Shamrock Dispatch has remained in the budget.

The amount budgeted does not mean that is the amount Shamrock Dispatch will receive for the year. It is the amount set aside. The amount received is recorded in the budget report at the end of the fiscal year. The end of the year budgets for 14-15, 15-16, and 16-17 are all available on

the "web", [www.co.wheeler.tx.us](http://www.co.wheeler.tx.us). Under Quicklinks go to Financial Transparency, Budget, 2017-18 Adopted Budget. Under Misc. Accounts, 01-599-83312 Shamrock Dispatch, the amount received by the Shamrock Dispatch shows to be 2014-15=\$90,869, 2015-16=\$80,003, 2016-17=\$73,281. **Budgeted for 2017-18 is \$90,000. Look it up!**

The contract approved September 25, 2017, was the same contract approved in 2010; due to changes in the ownership of the building Section VII of the contract needs to be rewritten. In 2013 the County of Wheeler made a trade with the City of Shamrock. The building in Shamrock, housing the dispatch, offices and an old jail cell, was traded for 5 acres of land owned by the City of Shamrock. The county now uses the 5 acres for the Wheeler County 4-H Shooting Range.

The contract with Shamrock was passed by the Commissioners, but had not been approved by the City of Shamrock and will not be officially in effect until signed by Shamrock. If this action is approved by the City of Shamrock, either of the two parties may terminate the contract effective not less than thirty days from date of such written notice.

The Shamrock Dispatch is used by the City of Shamrock for their Police Department, South Wheeler County Ambulance Service, Texas Highway Patrol and the City of McLean.

The City of Wheeler has a contract with Wheeler County. They pay each year for the Wheeler County Sheriff's Department to furnish protection and "answer calls" for the City of Wheeler. The contract with the City of Wheeler has been signed each year after the City of Wheeler discontinued their police department.

## Jernigan Sentenced In Bull Theft

Jaimie "Jim Bob" Jernigan, 46, pled guilty to charges of theft of livestock and obstruction, both third-degree felonies. The charges are the result of an investigation conducted by Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association (TSCRA) Special Ranger Ben Eggleston.

In May 2015, Eggleston was contacted by an area cattle raiser and the Wheeler County Sheriff's Office. He was advised that three months prior, the cattle raiser had made a verbal agreement with Jernigan to sell a bull and return the proceeds of the sale. Jernigan

took possession of the bull in February 2015 and reportedly sold it in Colorado soon after. However, he never returned the earnings to the rancher as promised. The bull's owner and local law enforcement officers contacted Jernigan several times to resolve the matter, but without success.

Eggleston continued the investigation, and contacted Colorado brand inspection authorities in an attempt to locate the bull. He soon received word from a Colorado brand inspector, who located the bull and confirmed that it

had indeed been purchased by private treaty in the state. After confirming the animal's identity, Eggleston and local law enforcement personally traveled to Colorado to take possession of the stolen bull. Within little more than week, Eggleston had returned the bull to its rightful owner.  
Jernigan was subsequently charged with theft of livestock and obstruction or retaliation. The case was brought to a close on Sept. 21, 2017, when he entered a guilty plea on both counts. The case was adjudicated in the 31st District Court, Wheeler County, Texas, and presided over by Judge Steven Emmert. As a condition of the plea bargain, Jernigan received deferred sentences of 10 years on the theft of livestock charge, and four years on the obstruction charge. He was also ordered to pay restitution, fines and court costs totaling more than \$5,200.

"It often takes a team effort to investigate and prosecute these crimes, and this case was no exception," said Eggleston. "I would like to thank everyone who assisted with the investigation, especially the Wheeler, Lipscomb and Hemphill County Sheriff's Offices, as well as Colorado Brand Inspection Director Cris Whitney and Inspectors Dan Buhr and Deb Vernon." TSCRA has 30 special rangers stationed strategically throughout Texas and Oklahoma who have in-depth knowledge of the cattle industry and are trained in all facets of law enforcement. All are commissioned as Special Rangers by the Texas Department of Public Safety and/or the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

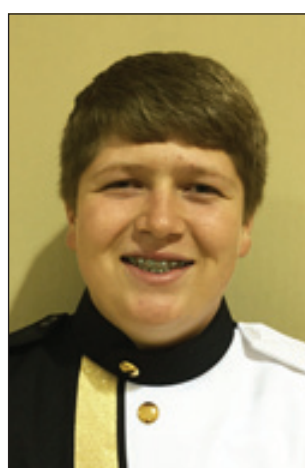

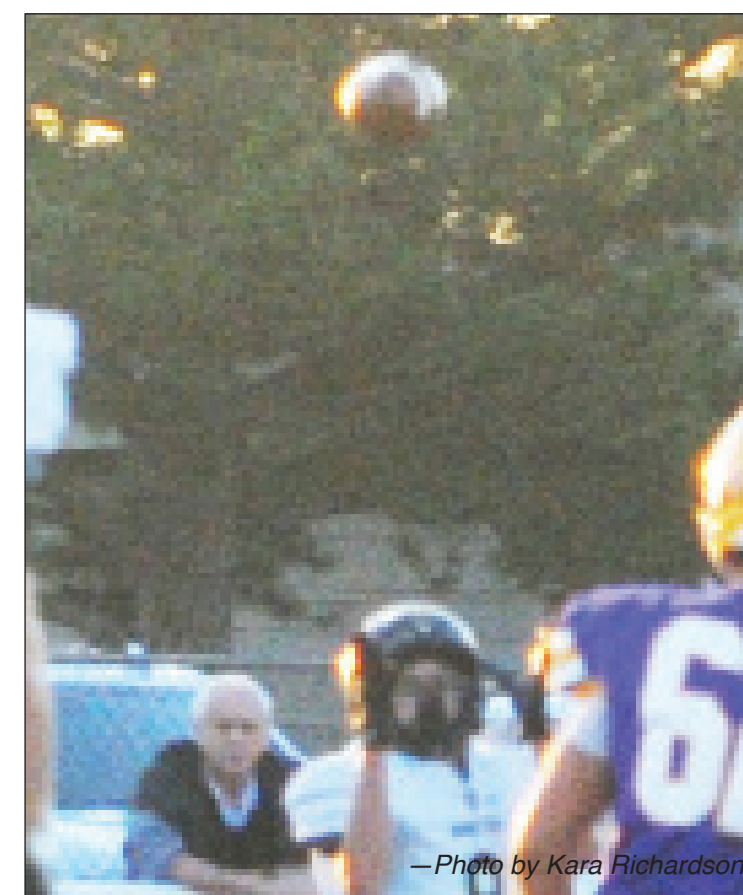
