Good luck Mustangs! Better luck next time!!! That's it!

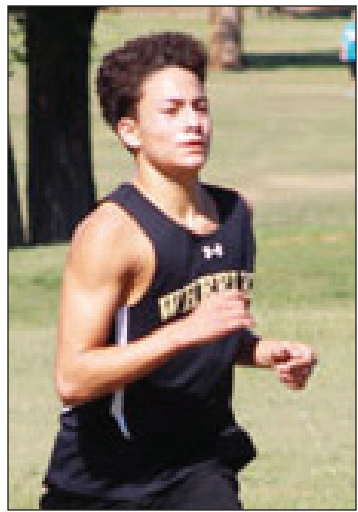
### Two Arrested At Cross Country Barn

On 10/12/2017 Deputy Reeves and Investigator Schlabs responded to a call at Cross Country Barn of two subjects appearing to be passed out in their car.

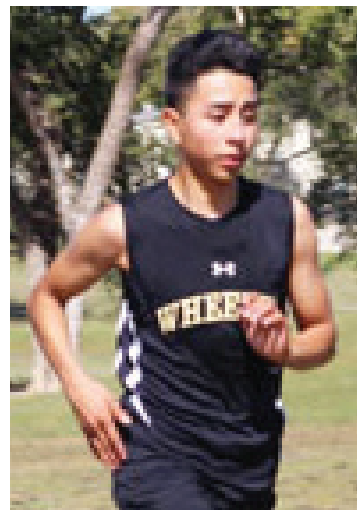

## ORDINANCE # 50

AN ORDINANCE by the City Council of the City of Mobeetie, Texas, Adopting and accepting for and on behalf of the City of Mobeetie, Wheeler County, Texas, the provisions of and amendments thereto, relating to cities and towns.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOBEETIE TEXAS:

Sec 1. Fireworks are prohibited in the City of Mobeetie except July 3rd-4th and only until 1 a.m. July 5th and on New Year's Eve from 12 a.m. (midnight) until 1 a.m. on New Year's Day. There are No

Exceptions.

Penalty: Any person who violates this shall be fined Twenty-five (\$25) and each and every offense shall be deemed a separate and complete offense.

This ordinance shall be effective 10 days after publishing in the local newspaper.

## ORDINANCE # 49

AN ORDINANCE by the City Council of the City of Mobeetie, Texas, Adopting and accepting for and on behalf of the City of Mobeetie, Wheeler County, Texas, the provisions of and amendments thereto, relating to cities and towns.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOBEETIE TEXAS: This is a revision to City Ordinance # 09.

Sec 1. If any person wishes to bring any livestock animals into an area designated as the east side Dickerson Street to the west side of Clinton Street; or from the North side of Fifth Street to the South side of

Sante Fe Street in Mobeetie, Wheeler County, Texas, you must appear at a Mobeetie City Council meeting and obtain permission from the city council. Certain criteria must be met for any animals other than dogs or cats to be allowed in this area.

Sec 2. The criteria to be met is:

- must own or have access to at least 150' of property.
- property must be fenced in.
- must have access to water.
- must be properly fed and cared for
- must keep property clean and free of foul odors.

Sec 3. No livestock animals are allowed to run at large in the City of Mobeetie.

Sec 4. The term "person" as used herein shall be construed to include both singular and plural, and shall mean and embrace any individual, corporation, association, partnership, or society, and their agents, servants, and employees.

Sec 5. Penalty. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this article shall be fined One Hundred Dollars (\$100), could be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and each and every day of such violation shall be deemed a

separate and complete offense.

Sec 6. The public importance of this measure and the fact that it is to the best interest of the inhabitance of the municipal corporation to adopt and accept the provisions of and the amendments thereto, at the earliest possible date constitutes for ordinance to be passed and take effect and be in full force from and after this passage, and it is so ordained.
