Two Men Injured In Wreck

Wheeler Volunteer Fire Department and North Wheeler County Ambulance Service were called to the scene of an Accident at "Nine Mile Station" east of Wheeler Thursday morning. The call went out at 9:00 a.m.

The collision of an "oil field" 18-wheeler and a one-ton oil field service truck resulted in the closing of Hwy 152 for a period of five and a half hours. The truck was on top of the pickup with two individuals pinned in the 1-ton pickup. The truck was traveling south on Hwy 592 and the pickup was traveling west on Hwy 152.

Two helicopters, Life Star from Pampa and AirVac from Elk City were called to the scene, along with three truck wreckers.

The Wheeler Fire Department spent two hours cutting through the back and the passenger side of the 1-ton and removing almost everything from the inside of the pickup before the two men could be removed. Both passengers of the 1-ton were transported via air to Oklahoma City.

Traffic was blocked until 2:30 p.m.

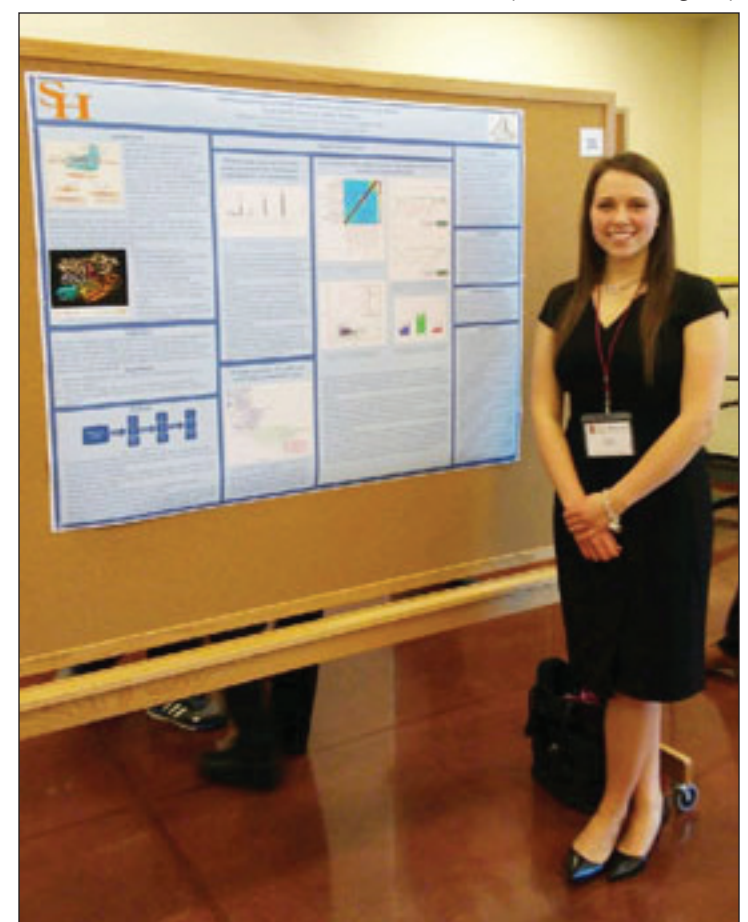

The Wheeler Volunteer Fire Department will host their 32nd Annual Pancake Breakfast on Saturday, November 4, 2017.

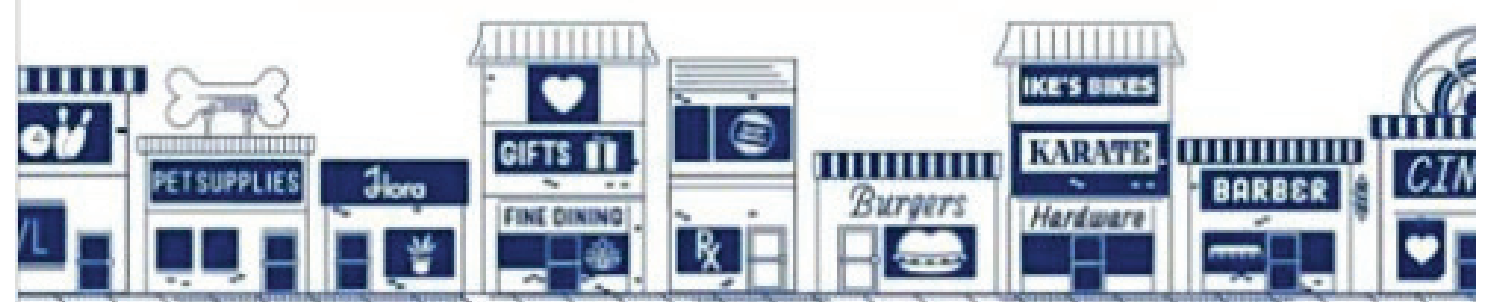
