There were budget amendments.

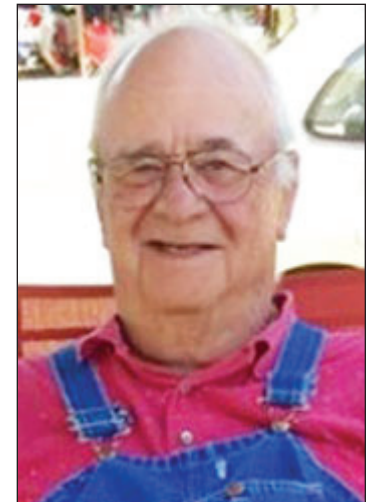

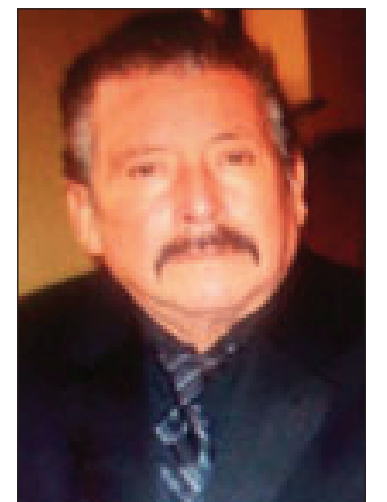
When the Wheeler team took on Fritch at the Miami Tournament they lost 37 to 44.

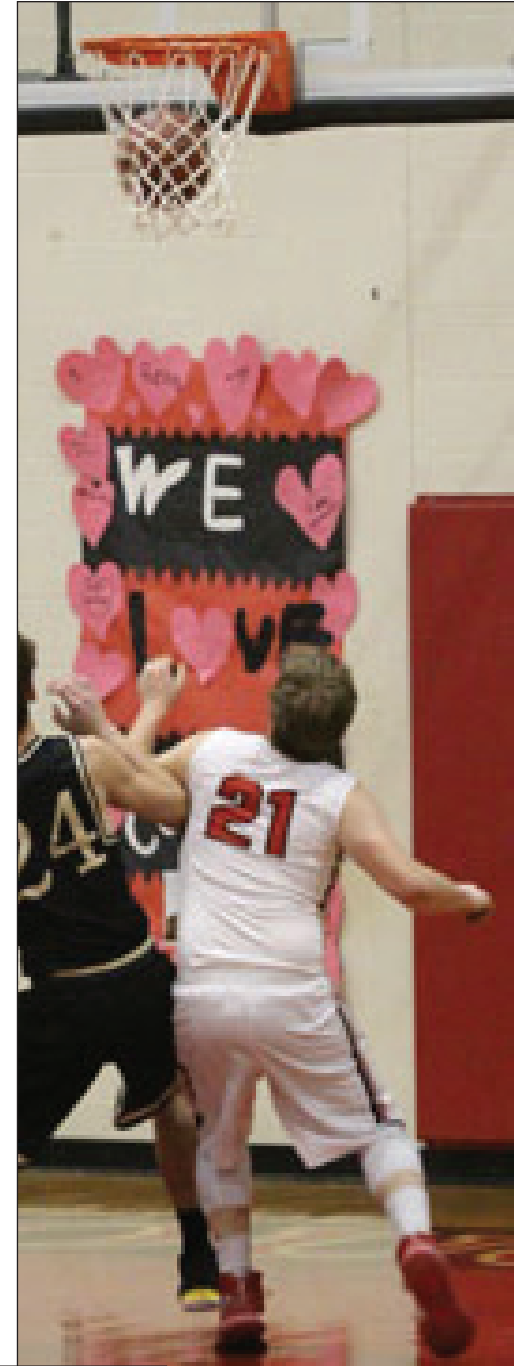

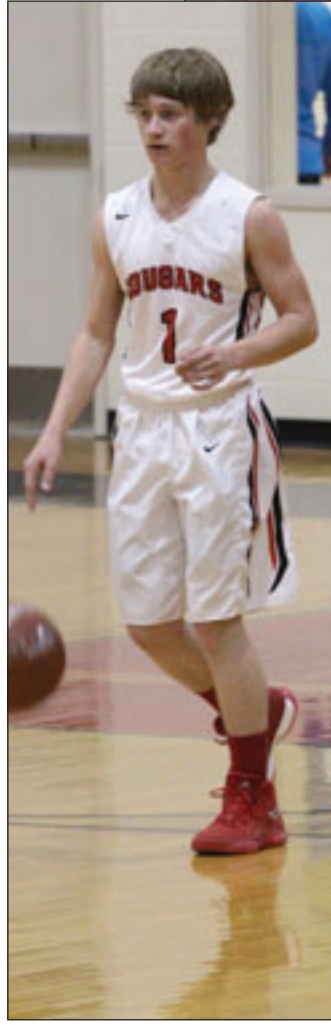

Stage One  
Burn Ban  
Order Prohibiting or Restricting Outdoor Burning

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court finds that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated area of the county create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Wheeler County that all outdoor burning is prohibited in the unincorporated area of the county for 90 days from the date of adoption of this Order, unless the restrictions are terminated earlier based on a determination made by the Texas Forest Service or this Court. This Order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code Sec. 352.081, and other applicable statutes. This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for:

- (1) Firefighter Training;
- (2) Planting or harvesting of agricultural crops;
- (3) Burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Sec. 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meet the standards of Sec. 153.047, Natural Resources

(Editor's Note: This recipe ran in 1971 I was requested to run it again. Slice, from the can. This is extra good toasted. If the slices crumble, put butter in skillet and toast.)

### ENGLISH MUFFIN BREAD

- Three 1-pound loaves
- 3 to 4 cups enriched flour
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 1/4 cup hot tap water
- 2 eggs
- 2 pkgs. dry yeast
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup salad oil
- Corn Meal

Combine 1 1/2 cups flour, yeast, sugar and salt. Add hot tap water (115 to 120°); mix until dry ingredients are moistened. Beat until smooth, about 2 minutes on electric mixer (300 strokes by hand). Blend in oil and eggs. Add flour to make a stiff batter. Beat until batter is smooth and elastic, about 1 minute with electric mixer or 150 strokes by hand. Cover and let rise in warm place (80 to 85°) until light and bubbly, about 1 hour. Stir down. Divide into 3 well-greased and corn meal-dusted 1 pound coffee cans. Cover and let rise in warm place, until doubled, about 30 minutes. (Dough should be at the top of the coffee cans.) Bake in preheated 375° oven 15 to 20 minutes, or until done. Let cool completely in coffee cans. Invert and shake to remove loaves. To serve, slice and toast. (Easiest to slice, using can to support bread.)

Code;

- (4) Public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations;
- Welding is allowed by commercial/professional welders under the following guidelines only:

(a) A spotter is required for each welder, each cutter, each grinder or for any activity that causes or may cause a spark.

(b) A diameter across the welding area shall be a minimum of 25 feet and clear of vegetation, if possible, and kept wet. The welding

diameter must be three times the height of the actual welding. Example: if welding is occurring ten (10) feet off the ground, a diameter of thirty (30) feet must be protected.

(c) A minimum of 200 gallons of pressured water must be available on site.

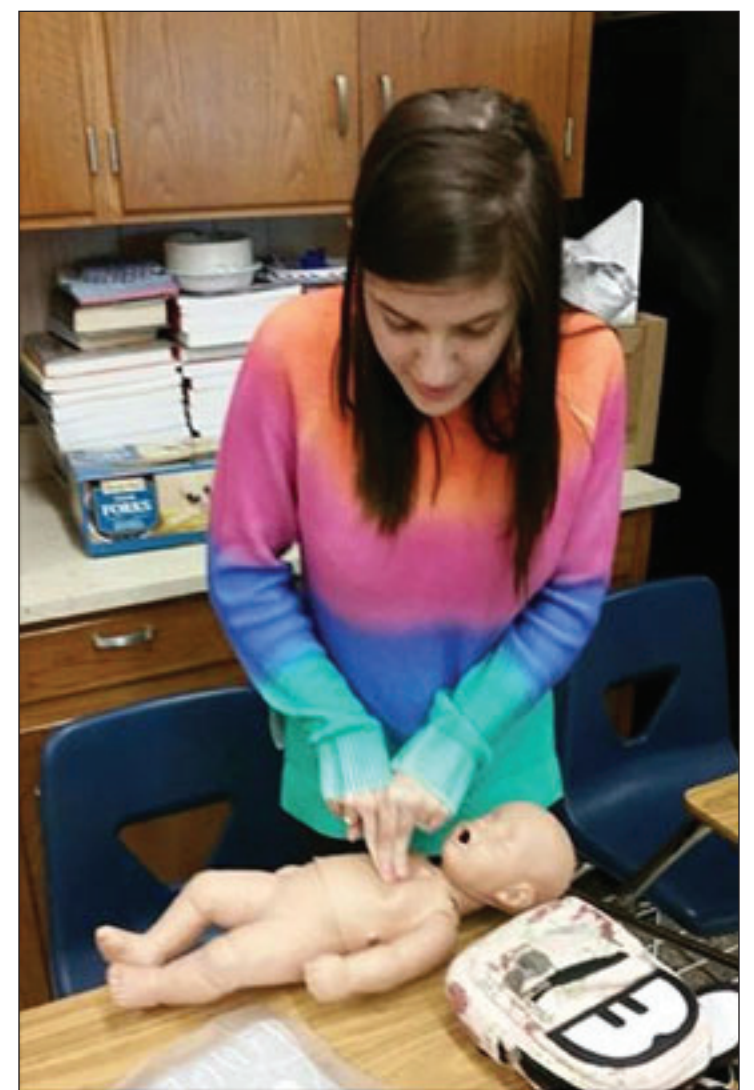

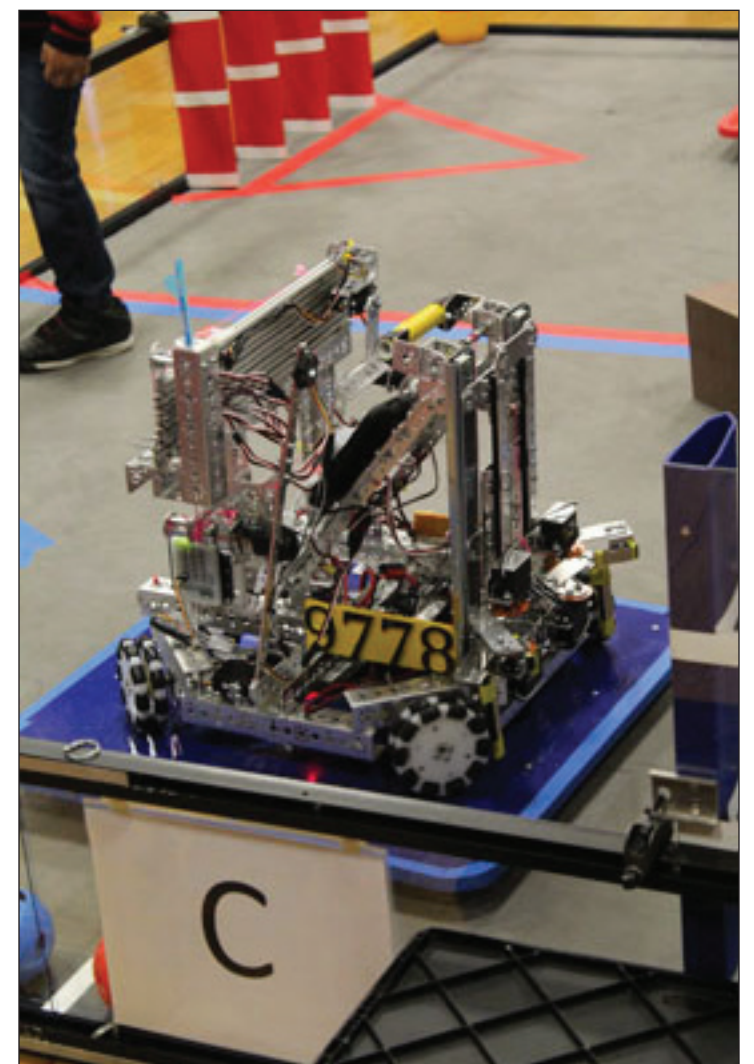
