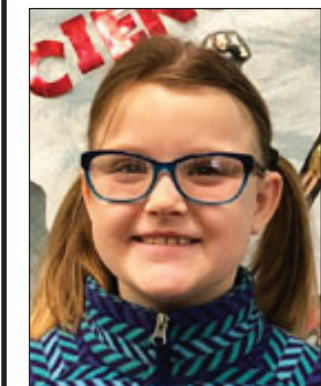

### 123 lbs. Marijuana Taken By Deputies

On 12/16/2017, Deputy Walden stopped a vehicle on Interstate 40 for a traffic violation. When Deputy Walden made contact with the driver, he could smell marijuana coming from the vehicle. The driver

and passenger's stories were not consistent when asked their end location.

Deputy Walden asked for consent to search the vehicle which was given. While Deputy Walden was still speaking with the driver, he admitted that the vehicle had been loaded with Marijuana before they left California. The driver

said they were taking the marijuana from Sacramento, California, to Charlotte, North Carolina.

The vehicle was then searched. In the back of the vehicle there were three suitcases and two plastics totes loaded with Marijuana. The driver and passenger were arrested for possession of

marijuana.

The marijuana located weighed approximately 123 pounds and is worth an estimated street value of \$1.1 million
