Marcia Joyce Cox Rives was born June 12, 1925, in Plano, Texas, to Dr. John M. and Helen Lea Short Cox. She passed away January 26, 2018, in Wheeler, Texas. Her family moved to Shamrock, Texas, in 1926, when Marcia was a year old. Marcia attended Shamrock Schools until she graduated from high school. She married E. M. "Curley" Rives in 1942. Shortly thereafter, Curley joined the Navy and trained for his ultimate service in the Marshall Islands during WWII..
