



Community Care: Determined— Treatment of Kindness

News sources frequently report of tragic incidents involving a person who has reached a personal breaking point and done something to injure themselves or others. Especially because of those incidents, few people would argue about the value of effective mental health treatment for those who need it.

However, as our country rushes to appropriately and effectively address the issue, let us not forget that each one of us can begin to address the problem in a meaningful way, every day, from this day forth.

How? By being kind to every person we encounter.

Certainly, the simple demonstration of kindness is no

replacement for tangible mental health treatment; however, consider this. Many mental health issues first begin with some form of mistreatment or abuse, which is the polar opposite of kindness. Now imagine, if instead of being mistreated, the person was treated with kindness; would their mental health issue even exist? What effect would kindness from just one person have on someone who feels they have been wronged?

Other known factors can affect people's mental health, including economic hardship, few social connections and living away from extended family members. In communities that have seen the evaporation of many jobs, financial woes

can affect the mood of many residents and therefore, the community as a whole.

For these and many other reasons, a simple act of kindness can be the one thing makes the day bearable for those who are struggling. Furthermore, being kind to others is a foundation of virtually all spiritual teachings throughout the world, regardless of religion or belief.

In recent years, a number of efforts intended to spread kindness has swept through the country. One such has been dubbed "pay it forward," where someone who benefits from a good deed repays it to others instead of to the original benefactor. Other such examples are comprehensive

lists titled Random Acts of Kindness that contain different demonstrations of kindness to someone else.

In the hustle of modern life, let us not forget that the simplest things we say and do can significantly impact others. The treatment of those we encounter on a daily basis has the potential to make enduring impact that can be either positive or negative.

A little kindness may be all someone needs, yet rarely receives. The most interesting aspect of being kind to someone else is that it frequently makes both parties feel good.

This week's question is: What is the impact of mistreatment and/or abuse?






