A 40 pound bag of 16-4-8 would contain $16 \% \mathrm{~N}, 4 \%$ P, and $8 \%$ K. To calculate total pounds of each nutrient contained in bag, multiply the total weigh of the bag by the nutrien percentage. Example: $40 \times$ $16 \%=6.4$ pounds of actual nitrogen. At the rate of 1 pound of nitrogen per 1,000 square feet, the 40 pound bag would treat 6
