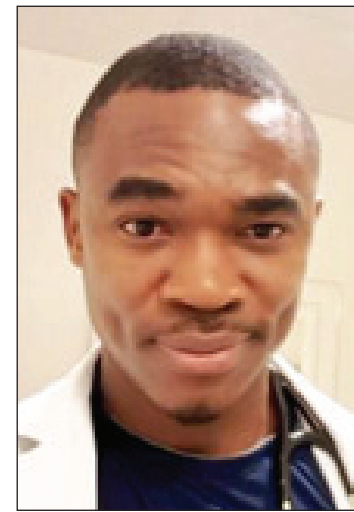

### Wheeler County Commissioners' Court

## County Spends \$82,426 For Vehicles

The Commissioners' Court of Wheeler County, Texas, met in regular session on Tuesday, October 9, 2018, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Courtroom of the Wheeler County Courthouse at 401 Main Street, Wheeler, Texas, to consider prior bills and discuss matters of mutual concern.

At 10:00 a.m. action was taken on the fifteen items on the agenda.

- The minutes of the previous meetings were approved.
- The monthly reports were accepted.
- The one budget amendment on the agenda was approved.
- There were no budget transfers.
- Numerous line item transfers were approved.
- No action was taken on the Wheeler County Policy Manual.
- No action was taken on the Burn Ban.
- The Continuing Education hours for Scott Porter, Tax Assessor, were accepted.
- The court approved the purchase of a 2019 Silverado 1500 4WD pickup from Holiday Ford and Holiday Chevrolet for Wheeler County Constable,

- Pct. 2, at a cost of \$39,426.00. Ware Chevrolet chose not to bid, due to the special equipment that had to be added, but will maintain the pickup.
- The purchase of a 2019 Chevrolet Silverado pickup from Ware Chevrolet for AgriLife Extension agent was approved. The cost is an estimated \$43,000.
- The 2016 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 HD pickup which had been used by the AgriLife Extension agent was purchased by Pct. 3 Commissioner for \$25,000.
- The court voted to approve the payment for telephone, utilities and cleaning for offices of Constable Pct. 2 and Department of Public Safety (DPS), effective 10-1-2018.
- The contract for software for the Indigent Health System (HIS) was approved at a cost of \$1,059—. This deals with medical expenses incurred by prisoners, both local and non-county prisoners to insure minimum cost to the county.
- The Sheriff's Office Asset Forfeiture Fund for the year ending 8/31/2018 was \$61,152.00.
- Court voted to pay the monthly bills in the amount of \$211,834.40.

- Discussion was held and in a motion by John, seconded by Randy, a motion was made to grant the OMJA with \$1,336.25, motion passed with all 4 members voting for, 0 against, 0 abstaining and 3 absent.
- Due to the city's resent audit, the discussion was held on the EDC Coordinator's job title to be changed from EDC Coordinator to EDC Director. The board asked Kristen to discuss with the city and check into their bylaws and table until next meeting.
- Discussion was held and in a motion by Randy and seconded by John, the motion passed to pay tuition of \$1500 and travel cost to Amarillo one time a month for Kristen to attend the Jody Holland Leadership Development Training for the next year. There are 12 sessions on leadership. The motion passed with all 4 members voting for, 0 against, 0 abstaining and 3 absent.
- Discussion was held on the joint meeting with the city and our next steps moving forward and implementing the ACCELERATION plan of action. No motion was made.

## Opal Boydston Is Buried October 15

Opal May Boydston, 105, of Allison died Thursday, October 11, 2018 in Allison.

Services were 2:00 pm Monday, October 15, 2018 in First Baptist Church in Allison with Bro. Ben Corbitt and Bro. Roger Johnson, officiating. Burial followed at Wheeler Cemetery.

Arrangements were by Robertson Funeral Directors of Wheeler.

Visitation was 4:00-6:00 PM Sunday at the funeral home.

Opal May Brown Boydston was born on October 18, 1912 near a bluff 8 miles from Booneville, Arkansas to Charlie D. Brown and Myrtle E. Love and went home to be with Lord and Savior on October 11, 2018 at the age of 105 years 11 months and 23 days. Opal grew up in the mountains of western Arkansas the second of 11 children. She grew up with a love of fishing, being outdoors, taking care of her siblings and being just a little bit onery. At 18 years of age, she chose a young man named Willie H. Boydston to be her husband because he didn't rock the boat. They were married October 25, 1930 at Earl Prairie Community near Booneville and enjoyed life together for 55 years.

They packed their meager belongings and headed west to the Texas Panhandle near Allison, Texas to start their family and life together. She served the Lord all of her life. To this union, was born Clifton Wayne, Curtis Ray, Willie Vance, Forrest Glenn and Juanita Kay Boydston.

There were many good times, a few hard times, but always plenty of love to hold them together. She lost the love of her life on October 27, 1985. Opal missed her husband terribly but continued to be a leader in her family and to tirelessly serve her Lord and Savior. Opal loved going to Church camps, taking bus trips to conferences and faithfully attending her home

**Firework Composition:** Have you ever thought about what makes fireworks different colors when they go off. This week the Kelton chemistry class tested different salts to see what color they would burn off as. We burned different salts such as copper sulfate, Iron chloride, and Sodium chloride. Once we started burning them they turned out to burn in different colors. After finding what colors they burned we had to find the wave length and the energy emitted by each color. With these experiments we learn how real-world things work. With this experiment we learned how fireworks work with the burning of these salts. One thing to keep in mind is that these salts aren't your everyday table salts they are chemical salts that have different purposes.

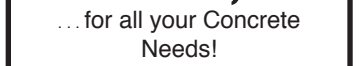

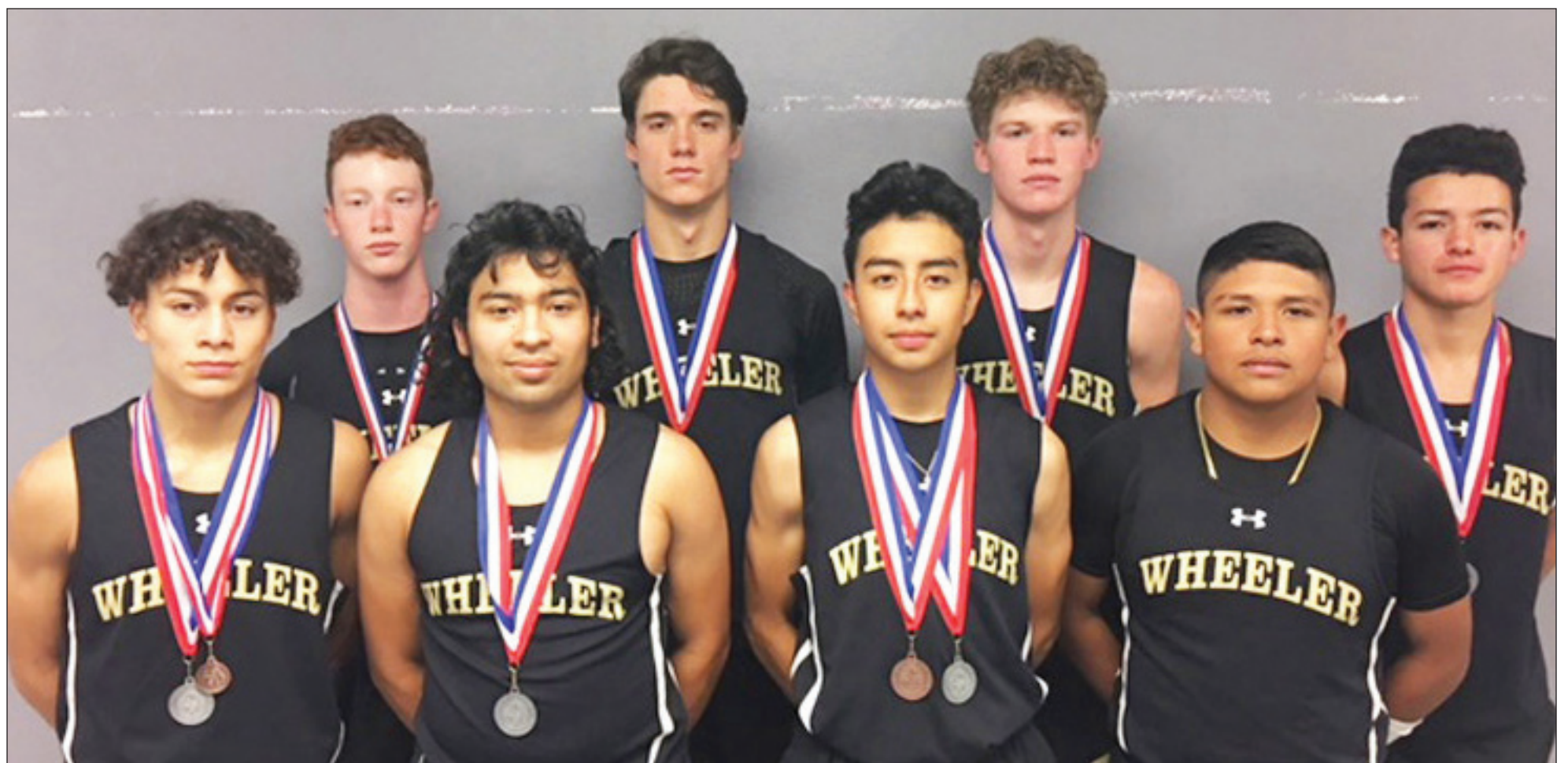

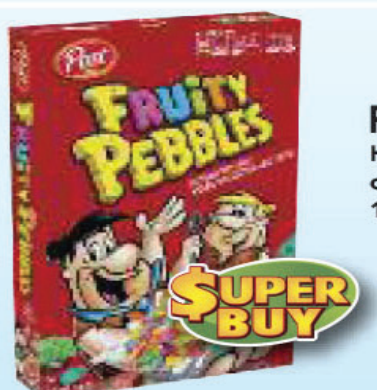
