Vietnam Veteran Relishes ‘Purple Heart’ Honor

David Gilmer wasn't so sure he would see a day like Tuesday when he returned from the Vietnam War.

Many of the servicemen coming home in the last '60s and early '70s didn't receive a hero's welcome. There were no ticker-tape parades. Gilmer, like many of his comrades, was met with protests and shouts of “baby-killer,” he said.

“I was shocked,” said Gilmer remembering that time more than 50 years ago.

But Tuesday, National Purple Heart Day, was different. Surrounded by 10 other recipients, members of the Military Order of the Purple Heart and about 30 onlook-

ers at the Ussery-Roan Texas State Veterans Home, Gilmer was praised for his sacrifice he made for his country.

“This means a whole lot to me and all the Vietnam veterans,” he said. “It's time we (Vietnam veterans) start getting recognized. I'm glad to see it in my lifetime.”

On Aug. 7, 1782, in Newburgh, N.Y., Gen. George Washington, the commander in chief of the Continental Army, created the “Badge of Military Merit.” The precursor to today's Purple Heart medal, which is awarded to soldiers killed or wounded in combat, consisted of a purple, heart-shaped piece of silk with the word Merit stitched across the front in silver.

Gilmer, who is from Briscoe

and raised in Wheeler, was 18 when he was drafted into the Army. He was going to enlist, but the draft beat him to it. He left West Texas for the Fort Lewis Military Base in Washington state. He left the



Pacific Northwest and headed to Southeast Asia in 1966.

We didn't know what to expect,” he said. “It was hot on that ship.”

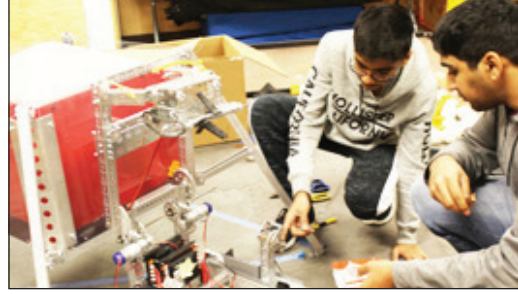
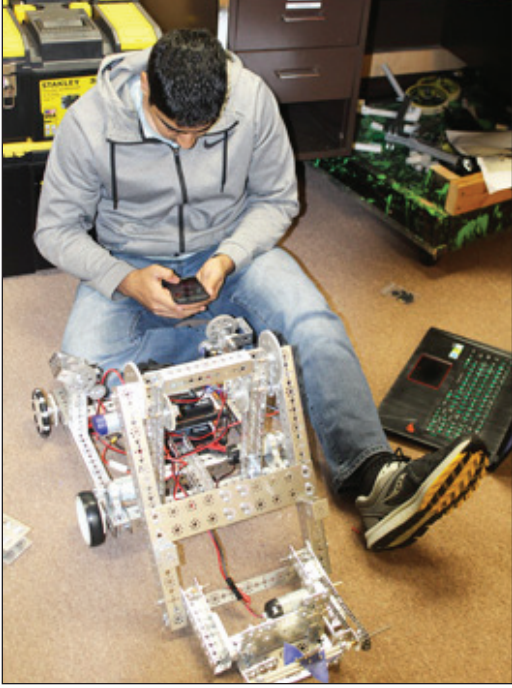

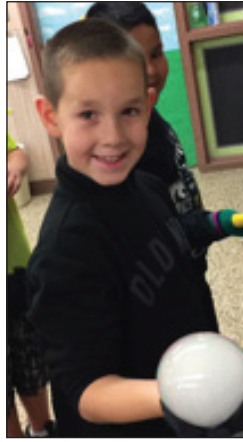

He said it took 17 days to get to Vietnam, three of those days were spent circling in the Pacific Ocean because they had arrived earlier than they were supposed to. He spent two years in the war.

"It was terrible," Gilmer said. "The heat and the rain; it was real bad."

One thing that helped him get through it was his future wife, Winnie.

"She wrote me a letter every single day," he said, "and she put a stick of gum in every letter."

Gilmer, 72, was wounded the year he arrived in country. He said he had to have a piece of bamboo removed from his eye and still has a little remaining in his left eye. He has scars on his arms.

He and Winnie married soon after her came home and have been married 51 years. She still lives at home, but because he suffers from seizures he lives at the Thomas E. Creek Medical Center. He used to live at Ussery-Roan. He said he's torn; he doesn't know which staff members from the two facilities he likes the most.

Gilmer is one of two surviving members of his platoon that fought in Vietnam. There were 48; now it's himself and Stanley Wurster, who comes from Illinois to visit each year.

The two can reminisce about happenings a lifetime ago in a land far away in a home that has changed for the better for many Vietnam veterans.

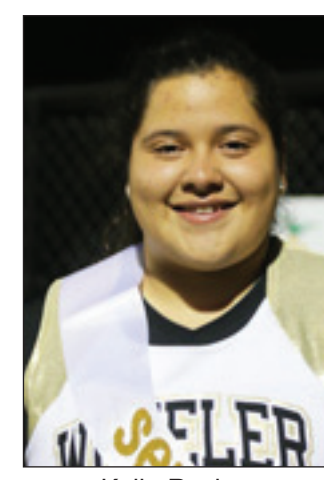

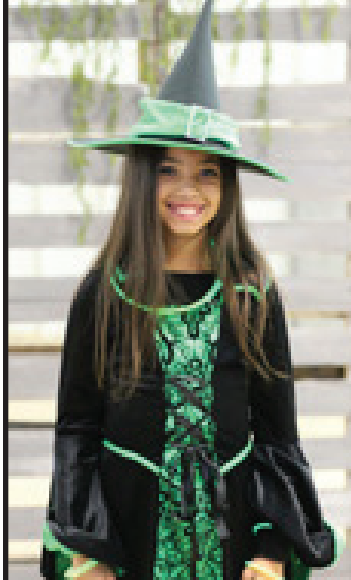

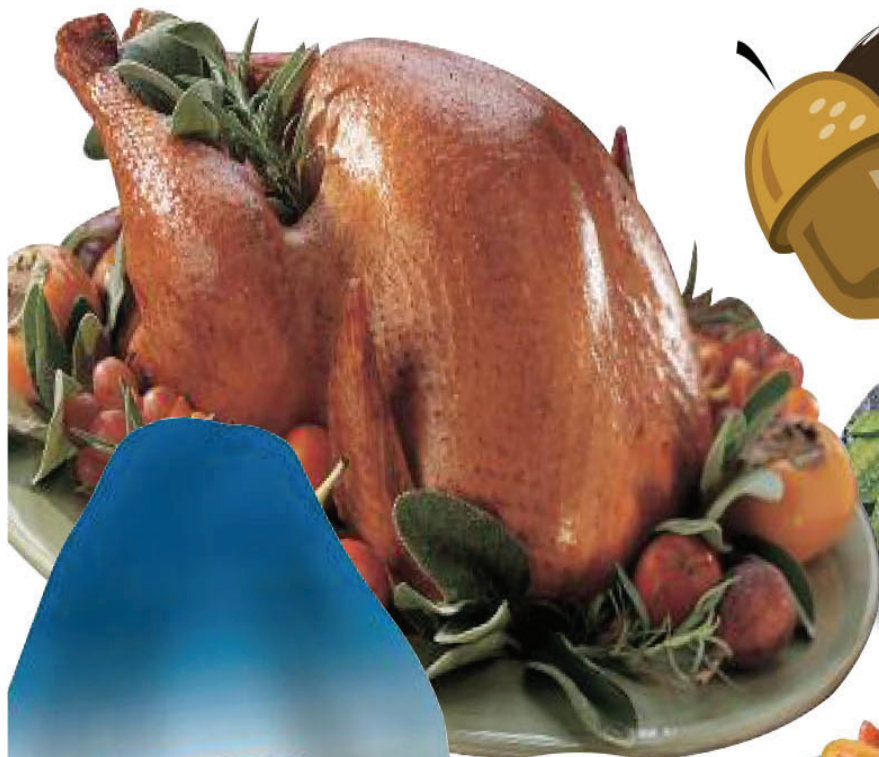
