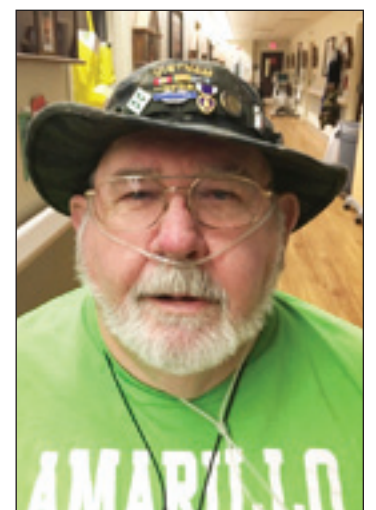

## Class Is Making 3-D Cell Models

The biology class at Kelton ISD is making various 3-D cell models. There are two types of cells, prokaryotic and eukaryotic. A eukaryotic cell has a nucleus and membrane-bound

organelles. Prokaryotic cells do not have a nucleus or membrane-bound organelles. Prokaryotes are only unicellular, meaning they are composed of only one cell. Eukaryotes can be unicel-

ular as well as multicellular. Animal, plant, and protist cells are eukaryotic, while bacteria cells are prokaryotic.

My group is currently working on a clay plant cell model. Our model must include a cell wall, plasma membrane, cytoplasm, mitochondria, chloroplasts, ribosomes, central vacuole, nucleus, nucleolus, smooth and rough endoplasmic reticulum, and the Golgi apparatus. We have finished the cell wall and we are about to start on the plasma membrane. Unlike animal cells, plant cells have cell walls. After we finish the plasma membrane, we will begin to work on the cytoplasm. The cytoplasm is a jelly-like substance that suspends the organelles. Next, we will add the organelles, nucleus, and nucleolus.

The nucleus is like the CEO of the cell. It contains the genetic information and protects DNA. The nucleolus is in the center of the nucleus. It creates rRNA, which make up ribosomes.

The other organelles are just as important as the nucleolus and nucleus. The chloroplasts in plant cells are very important. The chloroplasts are the only reason that plants can use photosynthesis. Without chloroplasts, plants wouldn't be able to survive because they wouldn't be able to produce their own food.

Mitochondria are like the

power plant of the cell. They break down food and release the energy as ATP (Adenosine Triphosphate). The mitochondria do this through a process called cellular respiration. Cellular respiration is a process that converts biochemical energy from nutrients into ATP.

The Golgi apparatus is similar to a post office because it sorts and ships proteins around the cell. It receives vesicles of proteins from the rough ER (endoplasmic reticulum) and then processes, sorts, and ships proteins to other organelles. Since the Golgi apparatus plays such a key role in cells, it interacts with many organelles.

There are two types of endoplasmic reticulum, rough and smooth. Smooth ER (endoplasmic reticulum) produces lipids, which are used in the maintenance of the cell membrane. The rough ER aids in the production of proteins. There are many ribosomes attached to the rough ER.

Only plant cells have a central vacuole. Vacuoles in animal cells are small and numerous, while plant cells have one large vacuole. A central vacuole is used for storage, and to maintain turgor pressure in plant cells. Turgor pressure is the force exerted on the cell wall in plants by stored water. The more water a plant has the greater the turgor pressure in the cell. Turgor pressure is what keeps a plant upright.

Ribosomes produce proteins. Even though they are not considered organelles, they are just as important. Protein is necessary for nearly all of the cell's reactions.

In biology, it is vital that all students understand cells and their functions. By creating cell models, we improve the class's understanding of cells as well as others. It also gives

assist an individual having a heart attack, Mental Health First Aid prepares participants to interact with a person experiencing a mental health crisis. Mental Health First Aiders learn a 5-step action plan that guides them through the process of reaching out and offering appropriate support.

"Through this program, we hope to take the fear and hesitation out of starting conversations about mental health and substance use problems," says Linda Rosenberg President and CEO of the National Council for Behavioral Health, which helped bring Mental Health First Aid to the U.S. in 2008. "When more people are equipped with the tools they need to start a dialogue, more people can get the help they may need."

In just ten years, Mental Health First Aid has become a full-blown movement in the United States—more than 1 million people are certified Mental Health First Aiders, and that number is growing every day.

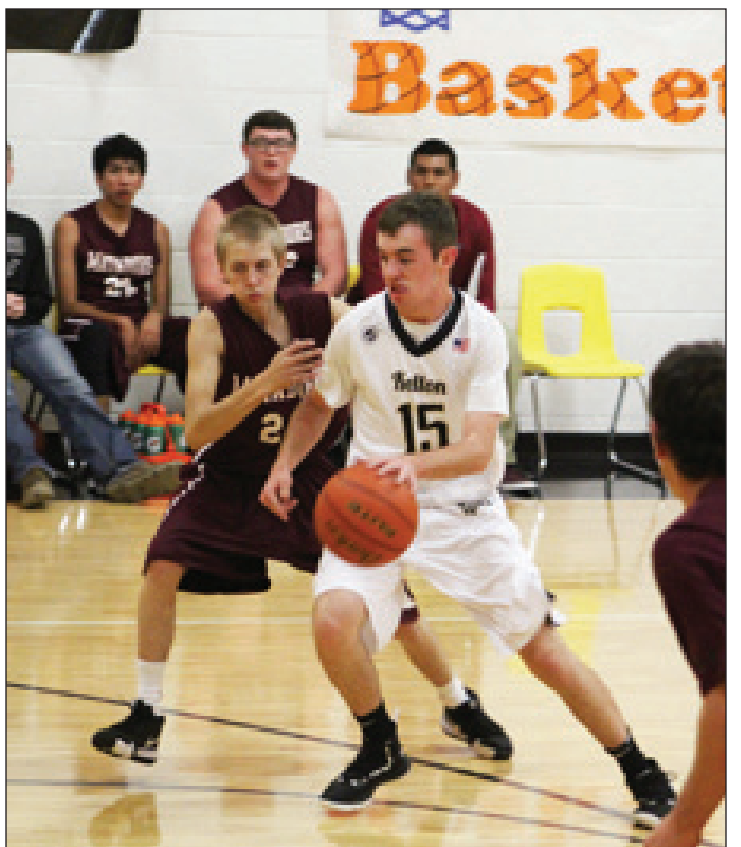

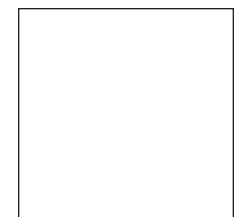

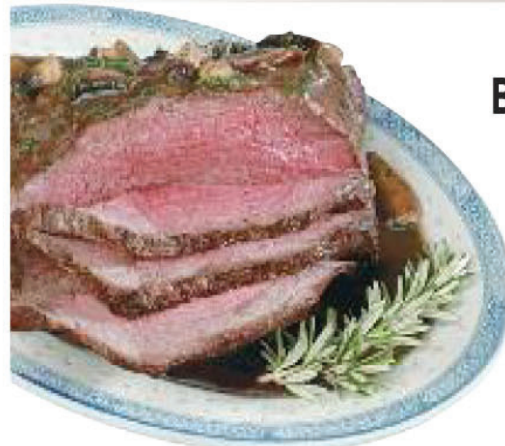
