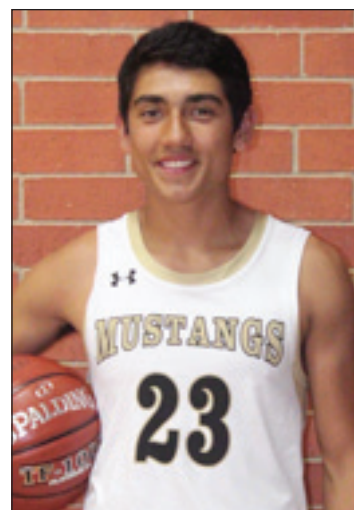

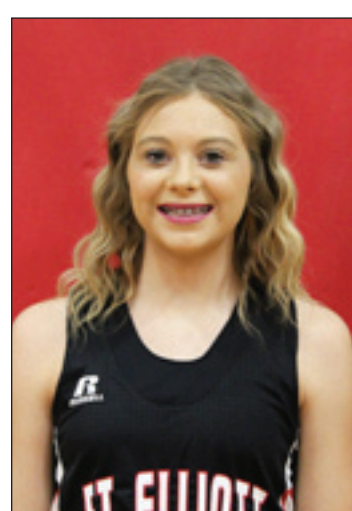

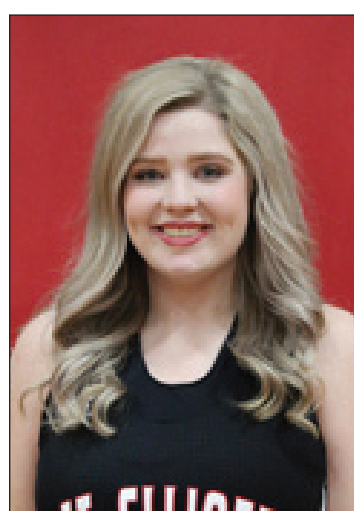

BURN BAN IS LIFTED

The Commissioners' Court of Wheeler County, Texas, met in regular session on Monday, March 25, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Courtroom of the Wheeler County Courthouse, 401 Main Street, Wheeler, Texas, to consider prior bills and discuss matters of mutual concern.

At 10:00 a.m. court reconvened to address the 13 items on the agenda.

- There were no minutes of precious meetings to approve.
- There were no budget amendments.
- There were no budget transfers.
- Three line item transfers

were approved.

• The county wide burn ban was lifted, as of Monday, March 25, 2019.

• No revisions to the Wheeler County Policy Manual were presented.

• The treasurers' report was presented with the amount of \$142,593.35 for the period commencing 03/12/2019 and ending 03/21/2019.

• Scott Porter, Tax Assessor, received approval to hire Christian Hefley as a third deputy as of 4/15/2019. Her salary will be \$3,169.30 per month.
