When a tornado or severe thunderstorm "watch" is issued, it means that tornadoes or severe weather are possible in the area designated. On the other hand, a tornado or severe thunderstorm "warning" means that tornadoes or severe weather are occurring. Persons in or near the storm

path need to TAKE COVER **IMMEDIATELY!** **Stay away from windows,

doors and outside walls.

**In small buildings or homes, go to a basement or an interior part of the lowest level. Closets, bathrooms and interior halls offer the best protection many cases. Seek cover under something sturdy.

**In schools, local businesses or hospitals go to a pre-designed shelter area. Interior hallways on the lower floor are usually best.
