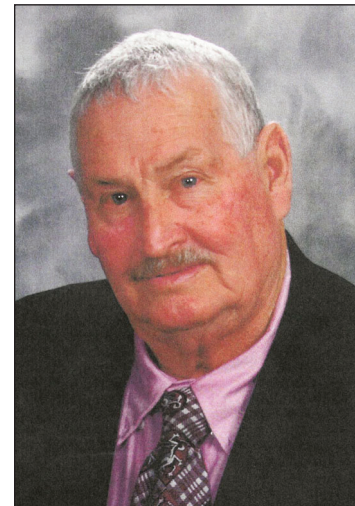
Juanita M. Patrick Death Is Reported

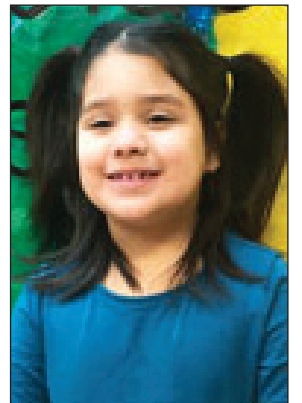

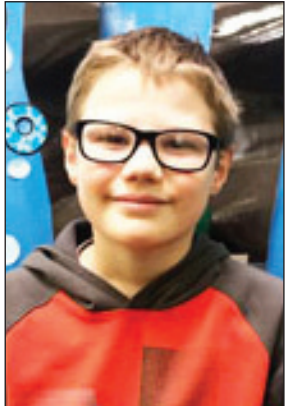
