

Wayne Vincent Kuehler was born June 15, 1936, the eldest of 9 children, to Louis and Elizabeth Kuehler in Munday, Texas. He graduated from Morton High School in 1953. He ran a local grocery, farmed and worked in the cotton gins and fields of Cochran County. He then moved to Dallas and was a store manager for Kroger.
