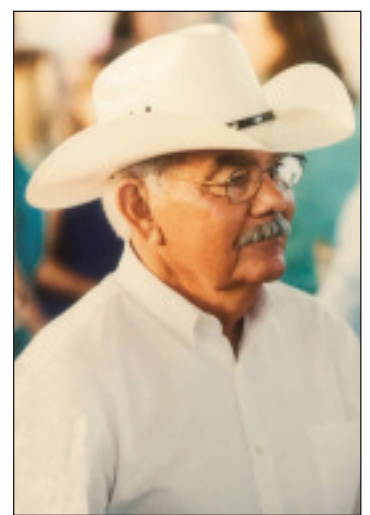

Merely Mustard

Have you ever looked up at the night sky and noticed the various aircraft flying around? I am not necessarily talking about UFOs, although perhaps I am talking about them unknowingly. Nevertheless, I am sure (rendering my opening question irrelevant, but for the need to have a lead-off sentence of some kind) you have observed such aircraft at some time or another. It is a source of amazement for me. It seems that most times I look in the night sky I see some form of blinking light moving across the sky.

And often there are a number of them in flight at any given time.

It often makes me wonder in awe just what is up there, and who, and where they are going. I also ponder why they are going to wherever it is, but that is really none of my business. The "when" question is answered, as the observation is made in real-time; that leaves "how" as the remaining frequently-asked investigative question, and I don't spend much time pondering that one. But that is not to say that I don't marvel at the feat.

In my mind, right or wrong, it would seem a less daring feat if I knew it were a commercial airliner that were flying across the night sky, since those planes get inspected and maintained with extreme frequency, thus the assumption is made that their equipment and their instruments are likely to be properly functioning. Again, right or wrong, I tend to suspect that smaller, privately-owned aircraft may not undergo as thorough or frequent inspection, which makes their presence in the night sky that (Continued Page 2)

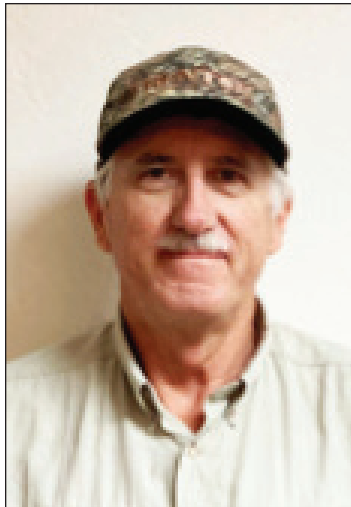


Betty Husted, 1935-2020

much more amazing to me. I am fascinated at the prospect of an individual with a private pilot's license being up in the night sky, totally blind but for his or her instruments, and therefore completely reliant on them and the accuracy of the flight path, to reach the destination safely. I marvel at the boldness of these individuals, although if I were to speak to them, they might tell me that I am overestimating the risk they are assuming.

But before I lose my train of thought altogether, I will return to my original line of thinking - I often look up in amazement and consider that up there, in the barren night sky, is an individual defying the all-powerful law of gravity, without the aid of daylight. This sentiment of wonder is amplified when such an observation is made during this time of year, when it is usually freezing after dark. I wonder how much colder it must be thousands of feet higher in the atmosphere. And I think, "Up there is someone's spouse, someone's child, someone's brother or sister, someone's friend, maybe someone's enemy...on their way to some place, coursing about the barren wilderness that is the freezing night sky, charting their own course and totally alone - if they are to arrive at their destination it will be up to them to make that happen. And the sheer number of such observations is striking.

Again, I may be overstating the achievement, as perhaps one who has never operated

a car might be amazed at one who could drive safely somewhere. I don't know, because I have no experience flying an aircraft, so I am left to wonder. But this is not a wonder that prompts me to find out - there are those curiosities which motivate the wonderer to try things for his or her self, otherwise the itch would never be scratched, the curiosity would never be satiated, as there is no way to truly know how something is or feels if second-hand is the nearest one experiences it - no, I am satisfied to look up and wonder. I do know a few pilots who I might ask, should my curiosity grow to the point that it demands my asking, but for now I am satisfied to look up and wonder. It may be better not to know, as I might find the truth more boring than my imagination. It seems to me that the truth tends to be not as exciting as what children may imagine it is. Perhaps we never grow out of that.

Producers to Complete Crop Acreage Reports for Fall-Seeded Crops

The USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) reminds agricultural producers in Wheeler County to complete crop acreage reports by the January 15, 2021, for fall-seeded small grains.

"To make sure you're eligible for many USDA programs, you need to file an accurate crop acreage report by the applicable deadline," said Janee Cross, FSA acting county executive director.

The following acreage reporting dates are applicable for Wheeler County:

December 15, 2020
Grass for NAP Producers
January 15, 2021
Wheat, Rye, Triticale

To complete your acreage report, please call the Wheeler County FSA office to schedule an appointment. FSA can work with producers to file timely acreage reports by phone, email, online tools and virtual meetings as well as by appointment in person.

The Wheeler County FSA office will provide maps to producers along with instructions for completing and returning the maps through either mail, email or com-

cially available free and secure online tools such as Box and OneSpan. After planting is complete, producers must return the signed form certifying their acreage report to the FSA office through mail, email, Box, or OneSpan by the applicable deadline.

The following exception applies to acreage reporting dates:

- If the crop has not been planted by the acreage reporting date, the acreage must be reported no later than 15 calendar days after planting is completed.

- Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) policy holders should note that the acreage reporting date for NAP-covered crops is the earlier of the dates listed above or 15 calendar days before grazing or harvesting of the crop begins.

For questions, please call the Wheeler County FSA office at (806) 826-5578.

All USDA Service Centers are open for business, including some that are open to visitors to conduct business in person by appointment only. All Service Center visitors wishing to conduct business with FSA, Natural Resources Conservation Service or any other Service Center agency should call ahead and schedule an appointment. Service Centers that are open for appointments will pre-screen visitors based on health concerns or recent travel, and visitors must adhere to social distancing guidelines. Visitors are also required to wear a face covering during their

appointment. Our program delivery staff will be in the office, and they will be working with our producers in the office, by phone and using online tools. More information can be found at farmers.gov/coronavirus.
