Absentee voting for the November 8 General Election called to elect federal officers, Members of the State Legislature and state, district, county and precinct officers will get underway Monday, October 24, 2022. The last day to cast an early vote is Friday, November 4.

Polls for absentee voting will be open from Oct. 24 to Oct. 28 and Oct. 31 to Nov. 4 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The last day to apply for a ballot by mail is Friday, October 28, 2022. To apply for a ballot by mail, contact Margaret Dorman, P.O. Box 465, Wheeler, Texas 79096 or Margaret.dorman@co.wheeler.tx.us. The request must be received no later than the close of business on October 28, 2022.

The two locations for early voting are Wheeler County Clerk's office at the Courthouse, 401 Main Street in Wheeler and Shamrock City Hall, 114 West Second in Shamrock.

The ballot has undergone a change. Unopposed candidates' names and offices appear on the ballot in two special sections declared elected both in state and county elections; you will not vote on them.

I recently received a Safety Recall Notice from an automobile manufacturer, which stated that there might be a defect in my automobile and which, if present, might jeopardize my safety or the safety of the occupants of the vehicle if it were to be involved in a collision. Aside from the reality that there is no safe way to be involved in a collision, the recall notice was given to advise me of the potential of a problem with a component used (I wonder where said component was made?) in the manufacturing of the vehicle, and recommend that I not use the potentially-affected portion of the vehicle (the seating) until the problem was resolved by the manufacturer. The letter also stated that the problem is incapable of being resolved at present, because the manufacturer does not have the parts necessary to replace the potentially defective parts. I wonder where the replacement parts are made, and if they will originate from the same facility that made the ones which have shown to be faulty at times? If they originate from the same facility, I wonder what has changed that would cause the replacement parts to be more safe or functional than the potentially defective parts? If the replacement parts are not made in the same facility as the original parts, I wonder if any lesson has been learned concerning the sourcing of

parts?
After stating that the ultimate objective is to replace the maybe-defective part with a maybe-not-defective part which will become available at some future time, the letter ends with the opportunity to contact the manufacturer's Customer Assistance Center for questions or concerns. 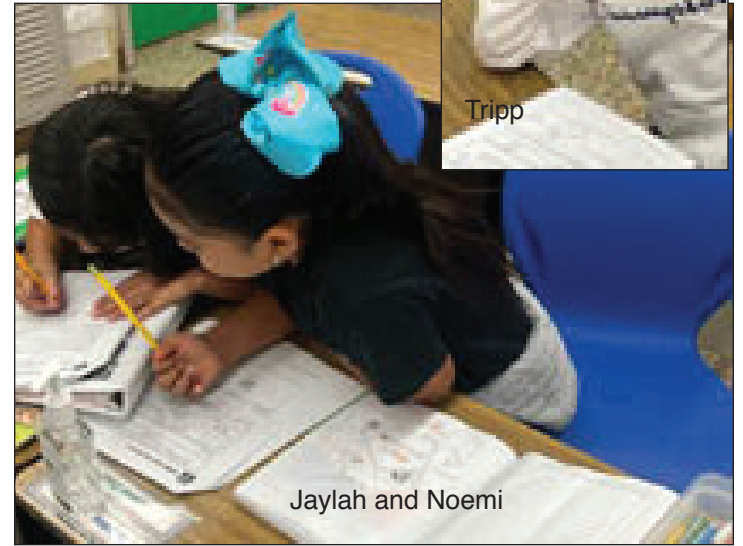
