



The "R" method is based on exhaustive calculations that show that a home to be air conditioned (or heated electrically) requires a given amount of re-sistance to heat flow for the equipment to be practical economically as well as to make the house completely comfortable.

To combat heat flow, mineral wool engineers worked out pertion resistance in the three areas where heat penetrates or escapes —ceilings, walls, and floors. These resistance standards are R-19 for ceilings, R-11 for walls, and R-13 for floors.
This standard conforms to the

new All-Weather Comfort Standards developed by electric utilities and manufacturers of air conditioning and electric heating equipment.
