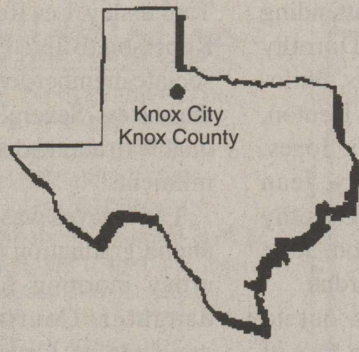
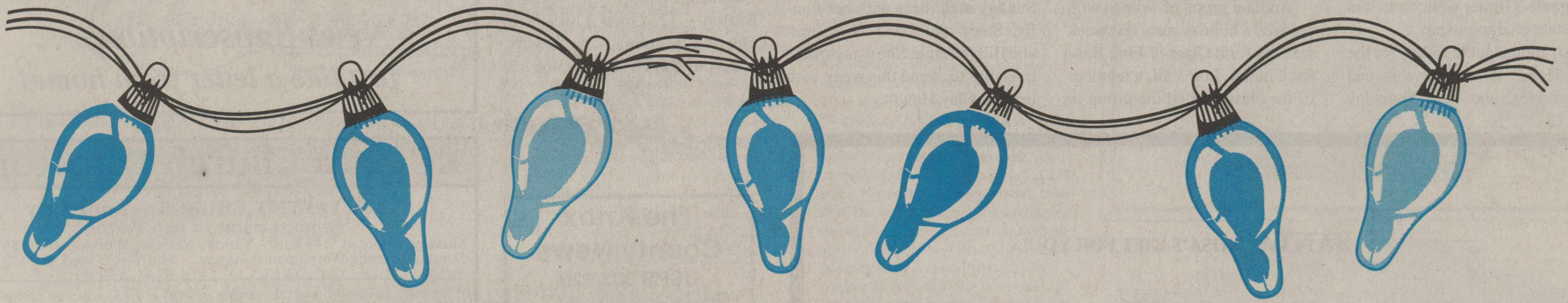

Never did we imagine that only a short time ago, we would be nearing the end of what I consider a legacy.

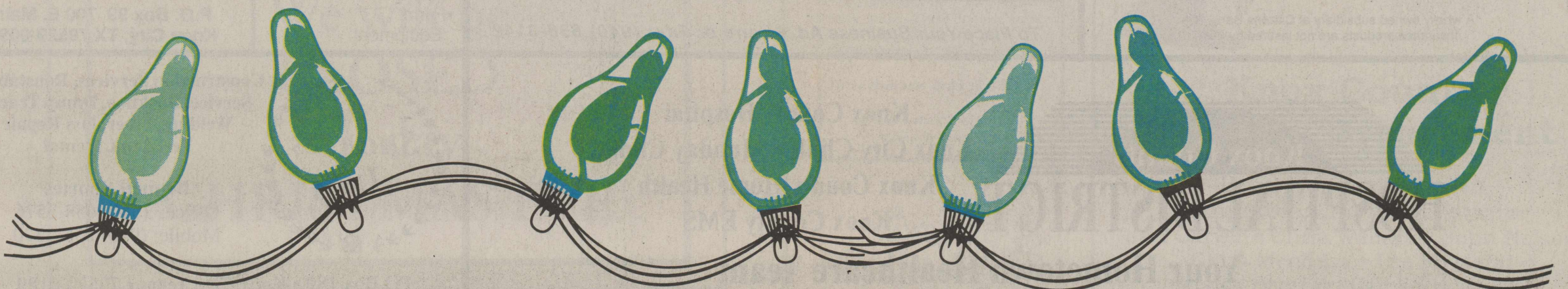
