1 can (8 oz.) Pillsbury ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ refrigerated Crescent

## Weather Whys

It seems like Texas always has some parts of the state that get It seems like Texas always has some parts of the state that get
snow this time of year. When is usually the last snowfall in Texas? Snow can fall in Texas later than you think, says Brent McRoberts of Texas A\&M University. The Amarillo area has received about 5 inches of snow several times in the month of May. "The latest snowfall in Texas is believed to have occurred May 6-7 in fell in McRoberts explains. "That's when over 9 inches of snow fell in the Amarillo and Panhandle areas. The two longest snow seasons have occurred in recent years. The longest was from Sept.
