## Hitler Masses Fleet Of 1,000 Planes In Effort To Hold Base

Adolf Hirler was reported massing a fleet of more than 1,000 planes in Southern Italy, Crete, Sardinia and Sicily in an attempt to defend the last Axis bases
in North Africa Wednesday as the Nazi-controlled Paris radio announced that German troops had "captured" Bizerte in Tunisia.
