belligerency it is we alone who can supply the arma-
ments, munitions, foodstuffs, and other supplies with
which this war can be won.

ly against Japan. No longer need we fear that the Allies
might be driven to complete defeat.
But defeat is relative. We . Whall have lost the war
if we do not win it absolutely, unconditionally, over-

too much. we might lose the complete victory that we
need.
So for Labor Day, 1943. let each individual do his
