### Rommel May Get Army's Command

LONDON-(A)-High Nazi leaders were understood Wednesday to be considering vesting supreme command of the German Army in Field Marshal Erwin Rommel to tighten anti-invasion defenses well as to forestall any anti-Hitler coup by the professional generals of the Junker caste.

Rommel recently has been reported touring Northwest Europe as a kind of anti-invasion chief and are indications that Field Marshal Karl Von Rundstedt may soon be removed from command held for nearly two years.

#### Goebbels Acknowledges Germans Have Suffered

LONDON -(A)- The Berlin ra dio said Wednesday Joseph Goebbels told his propaganda chiefs "it cannot be disputed that both the front and homeland were disposed to extremely harsh trials in the course of this year.

Acknowledging German sensitivity to the Allied nerve war, Goebbels issued new directives for 1944, and declared:

"While the heroically fighting German soldiers are making void all enemy attempts to destroy us the homeland proves worthy of them by putting up an admirable attitude to the brutal violence of the increased air terror and nerve offensive connected with it.





The machine, which is pulled by a Farmall tractor, will pick two rows in third or fourth gear, cleanthan field hands will drop in transferring it to their sacks, he said. The cotton on which he saw the machines operating had small stalks and all of it was open. Graham said the machine would handle any kind of cotton but it has to have dry bolls and must be open. It works best on a storm-proof cotton which is being planted in considerable quantities in the

Purchases Seed Farmers to whom he talked said the storm-proof cotton would make from one-fourth to one-half bale per acre, and reported that about 1,550 pound bolls would give a 500 staple. Graham purchased some of the seed and plans to plant stormproof cotton next year.

Graham believes the cotton pullers will cut the costs of harvesting cotton from the 1943 prices of \$25 to \$40 per bale to \$2 to \$10 per bale. Because many farmers, still remembering their experiences of at-tempting to raise and pick cotton this year, are undetermined whether to plant it next year or to rais grain instead. alk about an oil shortage, Dr. Gustav Egloff, president of the American Institue of Chemists, believes the United States has a surplus of 80 billion barrels.

"Twenty billion barrels can be obtained from known fields," says Dr. Egloff, who is also research director for the Universal Oil Products Company. "And three times that much is available from secondary methods, pumping gas into the sands to increase pressure on the

"If oil men are given the incentive to discover these new fields, there won't be any oil shortage. Right now we're finding new fields at a rate of 50 per cent less than we're consuming petroleum, but it's
