He draws on the manufacturer, the manufacturer increases production and employs more labor, as the laborer cams more, he buys more of clothes, food,
fumiture, amusement-the commodities which you sell or produce and hence the dollar you spend comes back to you.

We've started on the up-grade to a resumption of Prosperity now. A noted economist said in convention in Chicago the other day, "Americans today are consuming more goods than are being made up for replacement at present." This is the fore-runner of increased production and increased employment.

Continue spending and the wheels of commerce and industry will soon be humming in the key of prospenty but it's the degree in which you circulate your dollars that will determine the tempo of our return to normalcy.
