Foster Care Plan Reviewed The Department of Public
Welfare's new subsidized adoptions program is reduc-
ing the cost of foster case in ing the cost of foster care in
Texas, Welfare CommissionTexas, Welfare Commission-
er Raymond W. Vowell said today. The savings is being
realized for children realized for children placed
in state-subsidized adoptions
instean instead of remaining in state-paid foster care. The program begain Sep-
tember 1, 1975. It finds adoptive homes for hard-toplace children, and offers the adopting families subsidies
for such things as medical for such things as medical
and legal expenses. The program operates for children with mental or physical problems, or groups
of school age brothers and sisters.
The program was passed in 1971 by the 62nd Legisla-
ture. ture.
Bobbie Matthews, in charge of the program, said ge of the program, said
"Without some kind of financial assitance, we'd not be able to get adoption for
some children and we'd have some children and we'd have
to keep then in foster care until they were grown." It costs an average of $\$ 110$
a month to keep a child in $\frac{\text { a month to keep a child in }}{\text { foster care, Ms. Matthews }}$ foste
said.
Thirty-five children were
approved for state-paid approved for state-paid sub-
sidized adoption,. Matthews said. "By placing them into
adoption, we saved 30 adoption, we saved 30
percent over what it would percent over what it would
have cost if they'd stayed in foster care," said Matthews. "But the real value of the
program is not financial," program is not finiancial,",
said Vowell. "It means that a child who otherwise would not have a permanent home
with a family with a family, will have one.

producers are in a crisis
situation now that may affect
future beef supplies.
"There'll never be a better
time for housewives to fill
their freezers with bargain
beef," the Dalhart brain and
beef producer said.
"Many cattlemen will be
forced out of business unless
there is an upturn in cattle
prices soon," said the farm
leader.
"There's been a gradual
decrease in cattle prices all
summer, but the situation in
value of beef dropped about
25 percent in the past year 25 percent in the past year
while the retail value is down only 13 percent. According to USDA, the spread between cattle prices
and consumer beef prices and consumer beef price
has widened 9 cents a pounn since July, 1975, and is now at a near-record sp
