


Knox County Hospital is now offering CPR classes for individuals as well as groups.






Yes! We did print a paper last week - like we do every week! However, something in the postal system went wrong and they are floating around out there 'somewhere'.

Knox City Elementary will dismiss for Christmas break on Friday, December 20, at 12:50 p.m. Classes will resume at the regular time on Monday, January 6.




