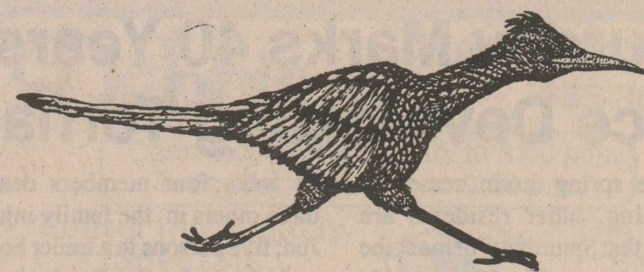
Rites Are Held Monday For 'Monk' Smith

The focus of Older Worker Week is to remind employers, both private and public, of the availability, experience, reliability and wisdom Older Texans possess.

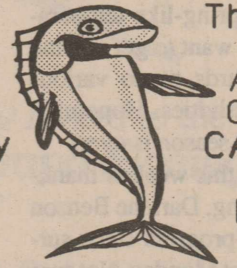
