The Internal Revenue Service defines a hobby as "activity nokt engaged in for profit."
There are several relevant factors the IRS will look at to determine whether or not you are deducting losses on a "hobby." The folling list does not include all the factors which may be considered: 1. Does the taxpayer conduct the activity in a complete and accurate books and records on the activity?
2. Does the taxpayer or his advisors have
expertise in this field? If the taxpayer or his expertise in this field? If the taxpayer or his advisors neither have the expertise nokr express an intent to learn about the activity, there may not be 3. How much motive. taxpayer on the activity?
4. Is there a reasonable expectation that the business will be profitable or that the assets will appreciate, allowing for an overall profit? 5. Has the taxpayer been successful in carrying
on similar activities in the past which he converted from unprofitable to profitable operations?
6. Have the losses in this activity continued beyond the normal period of time to bring such an operation into profitable status?
7. Are the occasional profits in relation to the alistic?
8. Does the taxpayer have substantial income may indicate other than this activity? Such source may indicate that this activity is not for profit.
9. Is this the tyme 9. Is this the type of activity that has elements o personal pleasure or recreation or does the lack o
these elements leave the appeal strictly for a profit? Your accountant can help you determine at what point your "hobby losses", change to "busines point yo,
