106th District COURT

Criminal cases heard in 106th Judicial District court proceedings under District Judge Reed Filley in Tahoka during the past three months resulted in a dozen individuals sentenced to various terms of incarceration or community supervision. The following were sentenced after submitting guilty pleas:

- Kaline Alexis Quintero, pled guilty to Possession of a Controlled Substance in Penalty Group 2 (less than 1 gram), a state jail felony incident that occurred 7-20-21; sentenced 9-12-22 to Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for 1 year

- Mark Benavides, pled guilty to Evading Arrest with a Motor Vehicle, a third degree felony incident that occurred 3-5-22; sentenced 9-12-22 to Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for 5 years

- Raul Hernandez-Navarrette, pled guilty to Possession of a Controlled Substance in Penalty Group 1 (1-4 grams), an incident that occurred 3-18-18; sentenced 8-15-22 to Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for 2 years

- Ashton Cox, pled guilty to Possession of a Controlled Substance in Penalty Group 2 (less than 1 gram), an incident that occurred 11-21-20; sentenced 8-15-22 by Judgement of Conviction by Court-Waiver of Jury Trial, to 3 years Community Supervision (in lieu of 2 years TDCJ)

- Miarah Ramos, pled guilty to Possession of a Controlled Substance in Penalty Group 2 (less than 1 gram), an incident that occurred 11-21-20; sentenced 8-15-22 by Judgement of Conviction by Court-Waiver of Jury Trial, to 3 years Community Supervision (in lieu of 2 years TDCJ)

- Alex Mejia Jr., pled guilty to Possession of Controlled Substance in Penalty Group 1 (less than 1 gram), a state jail felony incident that occurred 12-30-21; sentenced 8-15-22 to Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for 4 years

- Jeremy Adam Munoz, pled guilty to Obstruction or Retaliation, a third degree felony incident that occurred 4-16-21, originally sentenced to 7 years Community Supervision; sentenced 8-15-22 with Judgement Revoking Community Supervision and sentenced to 4 years in TDCJ, with sentence to run concurrent with another guilty plea for Assault Family/Household

Members With Previous Conviction, a third degree felony incident that occurred 10-8-21

- Raymond Lee Alvarez, pled guilty to Forgery of Financial Instrument (\$2,500-\$30,000), a state jail felony incident that occurred 4-29-22; sentenced 8-15-22 by Judgement of Conviction by Court-Waiver of Jury Trial, to 40 days in Lynn County Jail

- Robert Garza, pled guilty to Assault/Family Violence Count 1 of Indictment, a third degree felony incident that occurred 12-27-14 and originally sentenced on 7-20-15;

assessed 7-25-22 with Judgement Revoking Community Supervision, sentenced to 8 years in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) system

- Jose Guadalupe Calsoncit, pled guilty to Injury to Child/Elderly/Disabled Individual, a state jail felony incident that occurred 12-17-21; sentenced 7-25-22 by Judgement of Conviction by Court-Waiver of Jury Trial, to 197 days in Lynn County Jail, with sentencing to run concurrent with another guilty plea for Possession of a Controlled Substance Penalty Group 1 (less than 1 gram)

- Brandon Shelby Henley, pled guilty to Burglary of Habitation, a felony incident that occurred 6-7-19; sentenced 7-25-22 by Judgement of Conviction by Court-Waiver of Jury Trial, to 8 years in TDCJ

- Natasha Taylor, pled guilty to Possession of Controlled Substance Penalty Group 1 (1-4 grams), a third degree felony incident that occurred 9-10-21; sentenced 7-26-22 by Judgement of Conviction by Court-Waiver of Jury Trial, to 6 years in TDCJ

Lynn County Sheriff's Office (LCSSO) and Tahoka Police Department officers responded to mostly routine calls during the past week.

What was first reported as a stolen vehicle became a civil matter after officers discovered that the caller had let a friend borrow the vehicle that had been reported stolen, in a call on Oct. 2.

A mechanic in Wilson also reported possible theft on Sept. 28, telling officers that he had worked on a vehicle for a couple of months

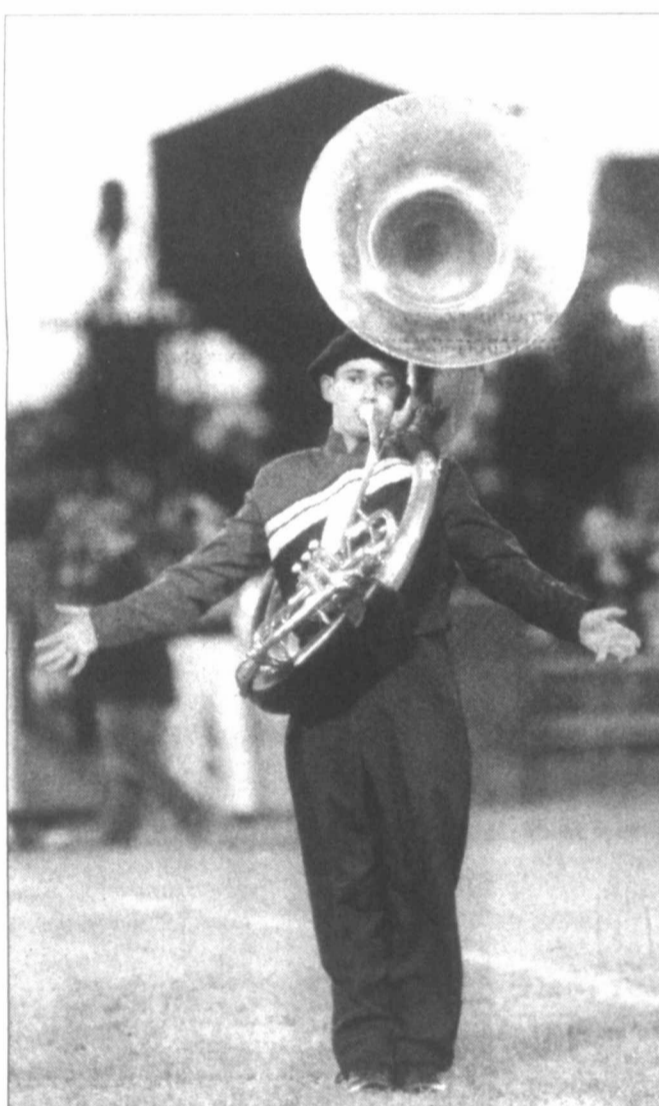

that was picked up from his property on Sunday evening and now the owner of the vehicle is claiming he stole the VIN plate off the vehicle. The mechanic said he wanted to file a theft report on the plate in order to note that he had not taken the plate off himself. According to the LCSO call sheet, he was advised that this would be a civil issue, due to him owning the business.

Tahoka Police and EMS responded to a residence in the 2000 block of South 7th Street at 8 a.m. Sept. 29, in response to a Life Alert alarm that was repeatedly sending out an alarm. As it turned out, the male individual who lived there had inadvertently placed the Life Alert in with his laundry in the washing machine, and the motion of the washing machine was activating the alert. The situation turned slightly humorous after the discovery, as officers and EMS were relieved that no one was in distress.

Police were alerted to suspicious activity at 5 p.m. Sept. 28 when a caller

reported that an individual was seen handing over a paper bag to a person in a vehicle that stopped at a residence in the 2000 block of N. 5th. An officer investigating the situation discovered that it was not a suspected drug exchange, however, but rather it was merely someone returning some earbuds that had been lost, to the owner.

Tahoka and New Home fire departments, Lynn County EMS and LCSO units all were dispatched to a residence on FM 179 at 3:12 p.m. Sept. 30, when the homeowner called to report that his residence was on fire but that no one was home at the time. LCSO received multiple calls reporting this fire. Upon arriving at the scene, deputies reported that a refrigerator was on fire but all else was okay, at which time the Tahoka VFD and EMS were canceled from the call.

Deputies responded to a residence on FM 211 at 4:15 p.m. Sept. 30 where a door was reportedly open. Deputies cleared the scene, and reported that it appeared that the wind may have blown

open the door.

A trampoline was reported stolen from a residence in the 1200 block of South 8th, at 1 p.m. Oct. 2.

Other calls throughout the week were for assisting stranded motorists, assisting EMS, reports of suspicious activity or vehicles, loud music, welfare concerns, a 9-1-1 hangup, domestic disturbances, child custody dispute standbys, and a report of an abandoned vehicle near the Lubbock/Lynn County line on FM 179.

member of the club, Club 33, or be invited by one. The idea of corporate sponsors and VIPs having their own special spot in the park came from Walt, but he died before the restaurant actually opened. But open it did, and the Club has been around since 1967, located at the top of a staircase in New

Orleans Square. Membership fees to join Club 33 are steep—Travel & Leisure estimates at least \$25,000—and while the oft-circulated "14-year" number is a seven-year-old statistic, becoming a member certainly isn't easy. You reportedly have to write a letter to Club 33 Services—and then they let you know whether they're even accepting members that year at all.

SLATON — Those wanting to celebrate any occasion, from grand to small, have another location to look at among the many in town.

Grand Occasions, located at 905 South 2nd Street in Slaton, opened in April, offering space indoors and out for just about any occasion.

Bryce Carter, owner, said he wanted to provide an

affordable venue that was still spectacular.

Ryan Nichols began working at LCAD on September 6, as the new Chief-in-Training. He will be designated as Chief Appraiser as soon as he completes his training for the position.

Nichols fills the position left vacant by the resignation of former Chief Appraiser Rebecca Norris, who resigned earlier this summer.

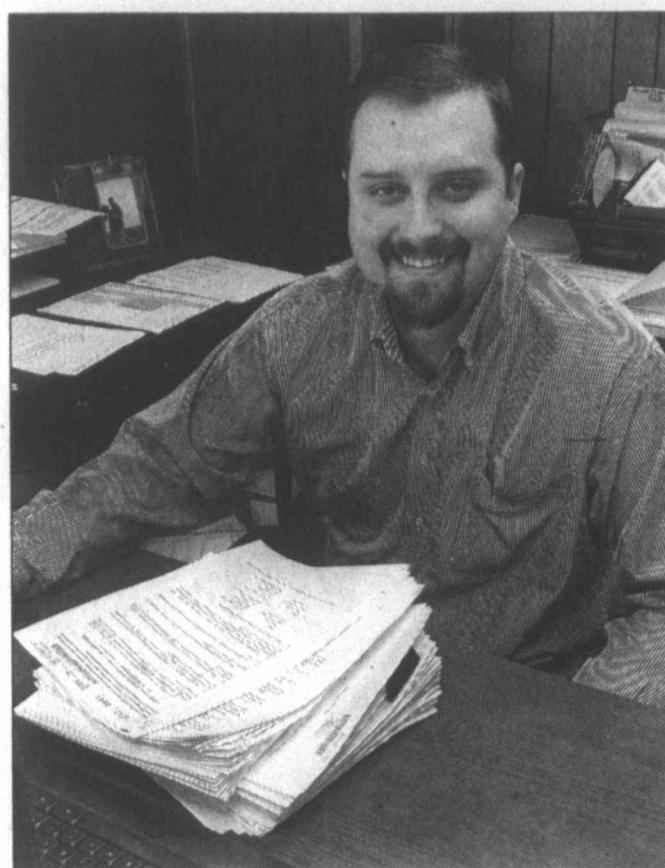
He comes to the position here with four years experience with the Lubbock County Appraisal District, and is eager to meet Lynn County citizens.

While he may be new to Lynn County, Nichols is the son of a cotton farmer and knows the hardships and lifestyle of agricultural

producers. Born in Seminole and raised in Big Spring, Nichols graduated from Texas Tech University and was employed in the Dallas area before taking a position with the Lubbock County Appraisal District.

He believes that his experience with the Lubbock CAD has prepared him for his new position here, and is ready to accept the challenges of serving as the chief appraiser. Nichols welcomes conversations with local citizens.

"If people want to come have a conversation with me about how the system works or other property tax issues, I want them to feel free to do that. I know that the property tax code is a complicated system, and it changes every 10 years. Tax code laws are changing constantly," said Nichols.
