Armstrong Temlock insulating board. Light is provided by eleven windows in the basement, which has two entrances, one leading to the front hall and another to the connecting garage.

The garage is connected with the house and is equipped with an overhead door which is automatically opened with the touch of a latch. The garage includes an overhead bedroom.

Ground floor of the building consists of living and dining room, kitchen, master bathroom, guest bedroom and main bedroom. A screened-in service porch at the rear connects with the kitchen and dining room. The living room has a large open fireplace built of fire brick and bronze tiling with mantle shelves of wood. Walls of the living and dining room are finished in stippled white. Walls and ceiling are insulated. Only the hall and guest bedroom are papered, all other rooms in the house having walls of insulated board on solid sheathing. Hardwood floors throughout were sanded, filled and waxed.

Roof is of Johns-Mansville asbestos shingles on solid sheathing and felt paper. Copper pipe was used in all plumbing in the building.
