## August Blood Drive Report

At the August 21st Friona Community Blood Drive, 42 individuals were able to donate. The blood collected was sent to 14 locations in Texas, Oklahoma, and Arkansas.

159 donations have been given so far this year with one more drive scheduled for November. This will be the biggest year since 2020 when there were 243 donations.

Six of the eight blood types were donated at the August drive. Only AB negative and B negative were not collected. The most common blood type in the United States is O positive (35%), while the least common is AB negative (1%).

Every two seconds, someone needs blood, a product that has no substitute and must be donated from volunteers just like you. No matter the donation you make, you will be saving the life of a neighbor in need

According to Texas Department of Public Safety Sgt. Cindy Barkley, the findings of the investigation have been turned over to the 287th Judicial District Attorney's Office.

As reported by the State Line Tribune, a special meeting of the Bovina City Council was called on Monday, August 25th at which time the Bovina City Manager Cesar Marquez informed council members that Police Chief Joe Orozco had been placed on administrative leave. Jose Rojo was named as acting Police Chief.

Members of the Friona Volunteer Fire Department are selling tickets to win a Kubota Zero Turn Mower. The mower was donated by Lone-Star Ag which is located in Friona and Dalhart. All the members of the Friona Volunteer Fire Department would like to thank everyone who has supported the fundraisers in the past. They truly appreciate how the community has been willing to support them in everything that they do.

All proceeds from the fundraiser will go to the Friona Volunteer Fire Department. Specifically, funds will be used in the purchase of two Brush Trucks. The first truck was ordered at a cost of \$265,000 and the second



truck will cost \$285,000. A grant of \$240,000 was used to defray the costs of Truck 1 and proceeds from previous and future fundraisers will be used to pay off the balance. It will be around a year be-

fore the fire department receives the first truck ordered and possibly 2 or more years before the second truck is received.

department. The drawing will take place on Saturday, September 14th at 1:00 p.m. in the city park. You must be 18 or older to enter and you do not have to be present to win.

you get up, Buster in an excited prance like an Arabian horse, high steps in procession with you to the trash. There he looks on with great anticipation that something might miss the trash can. Most of the time it didn't, occasionally it did. But every time he would prance to the trash can.

When the parade to the trash can was over and nothing missed the trash, undeterred Buster joined us in the living room, hopping on my lap and inspecting my shirt for the smallest of crumbs. (A side note here, Buster was fed twice daily and did not lack, he just loved those crumbs)

If God's blessings came in the form of crumbs vs. banquet feast, would you

still be interested? Could you, with great anticipation, prance to the trash can and hope for a little piece left over and call it a blessing? In Matthew 15, there is a Canaanite woman who could. Her daughter was possessed by a demon, and she was non-Jewish yet asked Jesus anyway. His seemingly resistance to her request is curious, but he is teaching here. He answers her by saying "you should not throw the children's bread to the dogs." Her response is, "Yes, but even the dogs get the crumbs that fall from the master's table." Jesus marveled at her faith. In a world where we want more stuff, bigger stuff, newer stuff would you take the crumbs?
