Depew said yesterday that the detailed scheme of the alliance between the Vanderbilt lines and the Pennsylvania railroad system had not been finally approved by the New York Central directors but would be approved some time this month. The scheme, Mr. Depew said had been under consideration some time. It was suggested by Mr. H. M. Twombly and was regarded with favor from the beginning. The fact that it establishes an advisory council with power to decide all questions of common interest that affect the two great eastern railroad systems invests with it much significance. It is expected that this advisory council will be organized early in January. Mr. Depew said that he believed the plan approved by the western president Monday would be put into successful operation. He did not think it would have any serious opposition.

New York, Dec. 18.-C. P. Huntington, president of the Southern Railroad, said yesterday that he believed the action of the western railroad presidents last Monday had been productive of good results. "The plan to establish an advisory board to look after the question of rates is going as it goes. I believe that the roads will act in harmony giving it a fair trial. Every feels that something must be done to maintain uniform rates if each man who attends meeting and voted for the arrangement will stand by it honestly, it will have a fair trial. I think, a useful trial. I do not believe any antagonism will be shown against this scheme by the Chicago Union or by Mr. Stickney. Certainly these roads are created as much as any others establishing uniform rates keeping railroad business on a fair basis."

NASHVILLE, Tenn., Dec. 18 - Hon. E. Wade, secretary of the state Democratic executive committee, and holding a similar position in the state Farmer's Alliance, who was delegate to the Ocala (Fla.) convention, said here to-day in an interview with an American reporter that he had been grossly and unjustly misrepresented in the dispatches from Ocala in regard to the alleged resolution binding every member of the Alliance to subscribe to the platform of the order and support no man for office who does not subscribe to these principles. He says no such resolution was offered by himself or any other delegate to that great convention. This report has created a great interchange between Democrats and Alliance men of this and adjoining states. Mr. Wade says: "So far as my individualities are concerned, they amount to but little, but as I have been placed before the country in a false attitude and the press generally have selected me as a target, and I deem it due myself to say that my views have undergone no change relative to the demands to the Alliance. I am not in favor of the sub-treasury bill of the government, ownership of railroads and telegraph lines, nor any other demand that places the organization in the attitude of subscribing to a policy of centralization and government paternalism. The Tennessee delegation at the Ocala meeting, which was composed of Governor-elect Buchanan, J. H. McDowell, W. C. Lightfoot and myself, endeavored by all honorable means to have the national organization adopt a broad, liberal and conservative policy so that we could go before the country with the motto inscribed on our banner: "Equal right to all and special favors to none." We were also unalterably opposed to any third-party movement, and agreed among ourselves that if this issue was forced we would retire from the body. However no attempt was made looking to this, and what ever action was taken by the so-called reform press after the adjourning of the National Alliance was no figure so far as the greatness of the order is concerned, and I apprehend that no member will consider for a moment the action of the members for the press as binding in the remotest degree on other individual action or a public question.

We would then be a step to rate cutting, ruinous competition and many useless expenditures. The money that now goes for special commissions, law backs and for salaries for unnecessary agents would be saved to the shareholders. Joint ownership of all the railroads is the only thing that would make uniformity of rebates certain."

FOSTER'S FORECAST.

The First Two Weeks in January Will Be Cold Snow and Rain.

St. Joseph, Mo., Dec. 19.—The next storm wave will be one to leave the Pacific coast about the 25th. When we get news from the North Pacific it will give assurance of very rough weather there on the 19th and 20th. This storm wave will pass the Eastern slope of the Rocky mountains about the 22d, cross the Mississippi valley from the 22d to 24th, and reach the Atlantic coast about the 25th. It will be of more than ordinary force and will affect all the states north of the 40th parallel in the way of snow and ice, and all the states south of that parallel with rain. Colder weather will follow this storm than followed the preceding one. The rainfall and the snow on the whole will largely increase, but will continue to be largely in countries near the sea level. The last storm was calculated to be most severe on the Atlantic coast about the 10th or 12th. I expect colder weather during the first two weeks in January, but the month will not be a severe one. I believe there will be an increase in rainfall in 1891 on the Mississippi and Missouri rivers, along the 40th degree of north latitude. May 1892 will bring the most disastrous storms since 1882-3.

WEATHER AND SCIENCE NOTES.

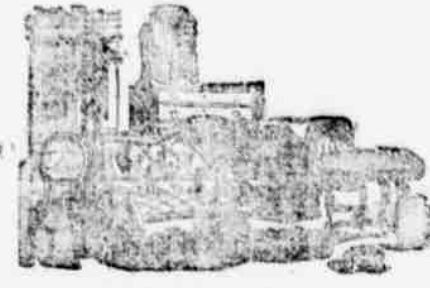
In studying meteorology of any of the physical sciences one of the most important items is the nature of attraction. It is usually spoken of as a pull, but this is an impossibility. It must be a push. To illustrate: The earth and all the planets have greater diameters through their equators than through the poles. Why? Astronomers say that while the earth was a heated and melted mass its rapid revolution on its axis caused it to elongate in the direction of its equator. But I deny that it was ever a melted mass any more than we now see in the volcanoes. Bodies of electricity are to solid matter like bodies of water expanding the lighter while the heavier sinks (punch). The earth throws off a body of electricity over its equator and solid bodies in space are pushed into that electrical body, and seeking its center are drawn to near the earth's equator, while the visible growth furnishes another. All the planets were originally comets and were pushed from space toward the sun's electric center, its equator. But their momentum caused them to pass beyond the sun's equator, and then the resistances of matter pushed them back toward the sun's electric belt again, and so they continue to vibrate, each time passing a little less distance beyond the sun's electric belt. The earth now only goes seven degrees north and south of the sun's equator and the moon only five degrees with and south of the earth's equator. Placing an electric body on one side of matter takes or drives away the resistance on the other side and pushes the matter into the center of the electrical body. Organized bodies like meteors, comets, moons and planets have no weight to send any other body as their matter presses equally toward their own centers. Another fact has much to do with these questions. Whenever matter moves in one direction other matter moves in the opposite direction. All physical scientists agree that electricity passes from the sun and planets over their equators and returns to them at their poles, and electricity passing from the earth

Haskell County.

Her Resources, Advantages, Pros-
gress and Future Prospects.

Topography, Water, Soil, Products,
Shipping Points, Railroads,
Public Schools and
Mail Facilities.

HASKELL county is situated in
the southern part of the Panhandle
on the line of the one-hundredth
Meridian west from Greenwich. It
is 1500 feet above the sea, and has
mild winters and summers. It is
20 miles square and contains 576-
000 acres of land. It was created
in 1858 from a part of Fannin and
Milam counties, and named in
honor of Charles Haskell, a young
Tennessean, who fell at the mas-
sacre at Goliad in 1835.

It remained unsettled until 1874
when there was one or two ranches
established. Other ranchmen fol-
lowed and in 1880 the county
could boast of 15 or 20 inhabitants.
There was no further development
until early in 1884, when the town
of Haskell was laid off and by de-
claring lots a few settlers were in-
duced to build residences, and in
January 1885 the county organized
with a polled vote of 57 electors.

Up to 1884 the soil had never
been turned by a plow, and the
people depended upon raising cat-
tle, sheep and horses as the rural
grasses furnished food both winter
and summer for horse and
cattle. The poorer people made money by
gathering many thousands of
buffalo bones and shipping them
east to be made into fertilizers for
use in the old states.

Experiments were made in 1885
with garden products, corn, wheat,
barley, rye, and cotton and the
results were beautiful.

In 1886 and 1887 the entire west,
from Dakota to Mexico suffered
from severe drought, and the
farmers of Haskell county, kept
green and in the fall of 1887 farm-
ing began in earnest, and the
crop of 1888 far surpassed all ex-
pectations, corn made 25 bushels
per acre, oats made from 30 to 100,
wheat from 15 to 25, rye 20, and
cotton, one-third to one-half bale
per acre, and sorghum, hay and
millet was so beautiful it was
largely considered as a part of the
general crop and there was no de-
mand for it in the local market.
The acreage in farms has been in-
creased to at least 50,000 acres.

TOPOGRAPHY.
The county is an undulating plain
with occasional creeks and branches.
It is bounded on the north by the
Capitanes stream, the south by
the Brazos, and on the west by
the Double Mountain Fork.

There are a few washes and
creeks, and the creeks and rivers
but few bridges, tracks and
poor and combined, their area in
Haskell county would not average
over 1000 feet that would not be
a fine agricultural land.

WATER.
It is traversed by numerous
creeks and branches, besides the
rivers mentioned, some of which
are hot and mineral springs of
pure water.

Besides the numerous branches
that flow from the north all the
time, the south half of the county
is traversed by Paint and Caliche
creeks with their numerous
tributaries draining the south half
of the county.

The north half is traversed by Lake
and Miller creeks whose tribu-
taries furnish water and drainage for
the same.

Besides the surface water there is
an abundance to be obtained by
digging from 15 to 40 feet,
and all of a good quality, some of
which is unsurpassed by that of any
section in the state for purity and
temperature.

SOIL.
The soil is an alluvial loam of
great depth and fertility, varying
in color from a red to a dark
chocolate, and by reason of its
porosity and friable nature, when
thoroughly plowed, readily drains
in the rainfall and in dry seasons
absorbs moisture from the atmo-
sphere, and for the like reasons the
soil readily drains itself of the sur-
plus water, thereby preventing
stagnation of the water and the
baking of the soil as well as the
germination of miasmata. It is of
peculiar qualities of soil that en-
able vegetation to withstand all vic-
itudes of weather.

Except mesquite grubs and
stumps, it is easily extracted,

there are no obstructions to plow
and the land being level, gener-
ally rolling, and easily worked, the
use of labor-saving implements at
once becomes pleasant and profit-
able. One man with machinery and
a little hired help has been known
to cultivate over 100 acres in grain
and cotton.

PRODUCTS.
Indian corn, wheat, oats, barley,
rye, durum corn, millet, sorghum,
cotton, beans, field peas, peacocks,
pumpkins, and all the squash fam-
ily, turnips and cotton are grown
successfully and profitably. Also
sweet potatoes do well, and Irish
potatoes as well as anywhere in the
South. Garden vegetables grow
to perfection, and melons luxuriate
in Haskell county soil, growing to
fine size of superior quality. Beside
the native grasses that grow on the
prairie, sustaining large numbers of
cattle, horses and sheep through-
out the year, Colorado grass grows
to great perfection and the hay
made from this grass forms a
valuable adjunct to the winter
pasture, in keeping stock over
winter.

YIELD AND PRICES OF FARM PRODUCTS.
The average yield of Indian corn
per acre is about 30 bushels and the
price varies from 50c to 1.25 per
bushel; the wheat yield for the
year 88—a dry year—ranged from
18 to 30 bushels—averaging 25
bushels per acre, and sold in the
home market for 90 cents to \$1.00
per bushel; oats yield 60 to 100
bushels per acre and usually sell at
25 cents per bushel; cotton yields
a half to three quarters of a bale
per acre, but owing to the great
distance to market its cultivation
is not engaged in to a great extent.
Other crops make good yields and
command corresponding prices.
Home made pork is usually worth
6 to 8 cents per pound; fresh beef
4 to 6 cents; home made butter,
best and delicious, usually sells at
25 cents per pound, chickens 15 to
25 cents each, and eggs 16 to 25
cents per dozen.

SHIPPING POINTS.
As yet Haskell has no railroad,
and our people do their principal
shipping to and from Abilene, a
town 60 miles south, in Taylor
county, on the Texas and Pacific
railroad, Albany on the H. & T. C.
45 miles from Haskell on the south
east, and Seymour on the W. V.
road 45 miles on the northeast.

RAILROADS.
There is one road being built
from Seymour to this place and
one to be built from Fort Worth
The Texas Central will have to
extend in a short time from Albany
or to the north, and Haskell
is on the line as originally
surveyed.

The land men of Austin have
organized a company to build a
road from that city to this sec-
tion of the state where they control
nearly all the land and one of the
principal members owns 100,000
acres in this and Knox county, be-
sides he owns the large addition to
the town of Haskell on the south.

Haskell is 70 miles north of the
T. & P. R. R. and 90 miles south
of the Ft. W. & D. R. R. and is
situated on the direct line of the
route that ever which the Rock
Island, and G. C. & S. F. propose
to extend their lines.

PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
Our school fund is perhaps the
best of any county in the north-
west. In addition to the amount
received from the state, about \$7.50
per capita, our commissioners court
have wisely executed a lease for
10 years of our 4 league of school
land, situated in the Panhandle,
the revenue from which added to
the amount received from the state
gives us a fund amply sufficient to
run the several schools of the county
ten months in the year. This
fund can also be drawn upon to
build school houses in any organ-
ized school community of the
county.

MAIL FACILITIES.
There is a daily mail service
from Haskell to Abilene via Anson
and a tri-weekly mail route to Ben-
jamin and to Seymour on the Wich-
ita valley railroad, these lines also
carry express and passengers.

RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS.
The religious and moral status of
the people of Haskell county will
compare favorably with that of any
county in the state. The Methodist, Baptist,
Christian, Old School and Camber-
land Presbyterians each have
organized churches in the town of
Haskell, and have preaching on
Sundays, also preaching at other
points in the county. We have a
good Union Sunday School, and
weekly prayer meeting that are
well attended.

HASKELL.
The town of Haskell is the county
seat, and is situated one and
one-half mile south of the center
of Haskell county, on a beautiful
table land, and is six years old
and has a population of 500.
Has no good well water as can be
found anywhere, which is secured
at a depth of 18 to 22 feet. Also has
two never failing springs of pure
water in the edge of town. Haskell
has five drygood and grocery
stores that sell goods at prices as
low as can be had in railroad
towns, with 50 cents per hun-
dred pounds for freight added,
and dry goods and groceries as cheap
as can be bought any where.
Two Millinery establishments one
good mill and also has two drug
stores, two hardware one furniture
one notion one hotel and two
restaurants, three blacksmith shops

two cabinet- and wood shops
one lumber yard two national
banks, one barber shop,
one silver smith shop or a saddlery
shop, one best and shoe shop,
two meat markets, two livery
stables, three doctors, 13 lawyers
and land agents, two first class
newspapers and job offices
and two saloons, all doing a
good business. The town of
Haskell with her natural advan-
tages, of location, climate, good wa-
ter and fertility of soil is destined
in the near future to be the queen
city of Northwest Texas, and rail-
road connection for Haskell is all
that is needed to accomplish these
advantages and resources.

In almost every neighborhood
of the older states and the thickly
settled portion of our own state
