Re cently there have been va- rious publications and discussions about the fact that Social Security is spending more money than it is taking rate, the social security trust funds will be depleted in a few years. <br> Mrs. James Harper, Manager of the Vernon Social Security Office states that this would only be true if Congress should fail to pass legislation to provide additional financing. Under the Social Security Law, Congress is responsible for seeing that the social security are not depleted. <br> It is true that the Social Security Administration has recently been paying ourmore than it has been taking in This situation is due in part, to higher unemployment and inflation. Another factor that must be considered in long range planning is the lower birth rate and increasing number of retirement age persons in proportion to the total population. <br> Congress will be given recommendations for corrective logislation in ample time to prevent any depletion of funds or any cutbacks in social security payments. We can be assured that Congress will take any necessary steps to keep the Social Security programs on a sound financial basis now and in years to rome. |
